The part of the heroine of the play is shared by Mrs. Kind Hearted and Miss Share-our Blessings, while the hero is our old time favorite, Mr. Generous Giver. Others important in the cast are General Chairman and her able sister, "Co" Chairman, Mrs. District Chairman, and that able and spirited Block Canvasser.

The action of the play is powerful in its very simplicity with no over-acting or boring pageantry to detract from the main vital interest of the plot. Some of the captions are noteworthy—"Doorbell Rings," "Block Canvasser meets Mrs. Kind Hearted," "Explains Mission," "Mrs. Kind Hearted finds check book after exhaustive search of closet, pantry, bureau drawer, and desk." "Block Canvasser and Mrs. K. H. clasp hands knowingly." Fade out. Curtain.

The unique feature of this annual

drama is that there are no spotlights necessary, no directors to shout at the actors. The impetus for the entire action and its reason for being so vitally interesting is a well-known camp on the north shore at Lake Bluff, known as Arden Shore, and each year we of Winnetka are becoming more and more glad and willing to take our part in the "Drama of Giving" and to share our little or much, as our case may be, with an organization that does as much good work in exactly the way in which it is most needed as Arden Shore. Each year there is a large quota of newcomers to Winnetka, to whom we gladly explain that Arden Shore is a rest and building-up camp for under-nourished boys each winter, and gives a much-needed and well-planned summer vacation to thousands of mothers and children each summer.

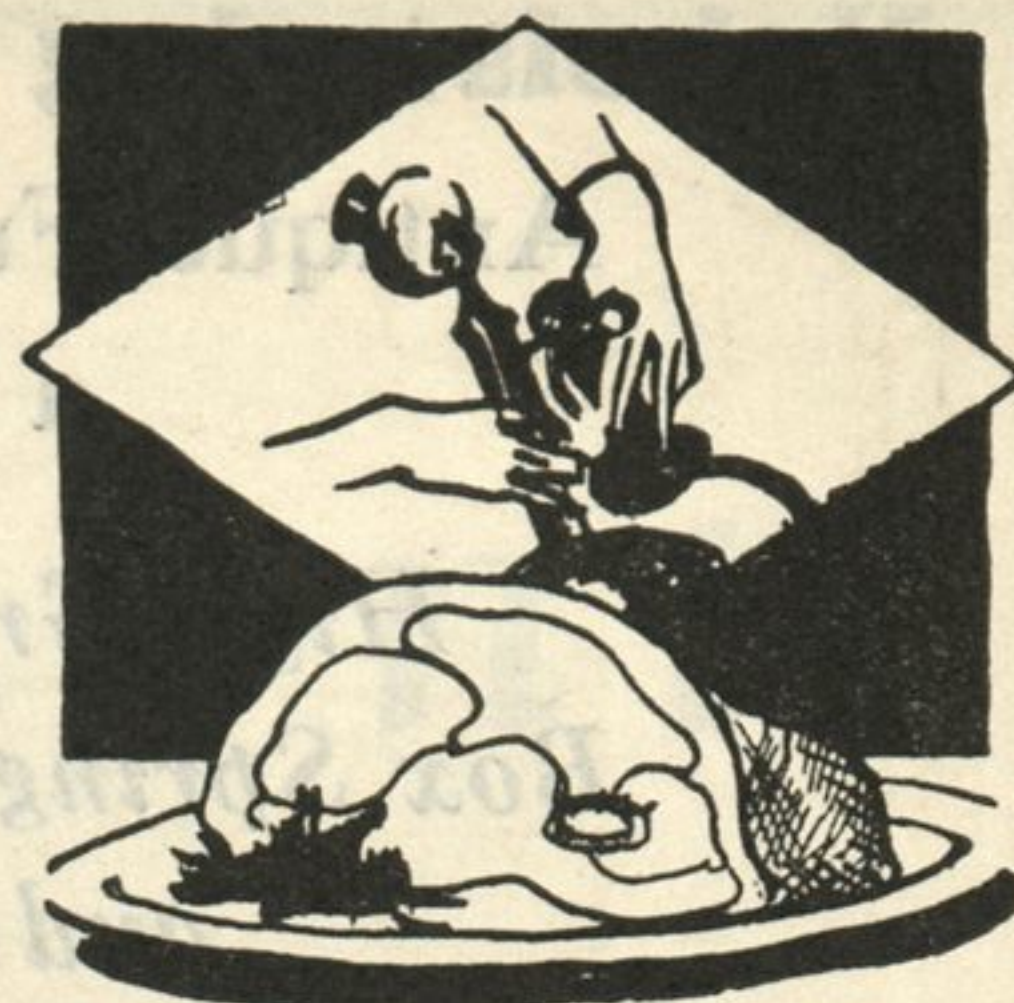
