

GIRLS OUTRANK BOYS ON N. T. HONOR ROLL

Three Hundred and Seven Students Achieve High Scholastic Rating in Past Month

A total of 307 students are listed on the Honor and Honorable Mention rolls for the second month of the second semester, just concluded, at New Trier High school. 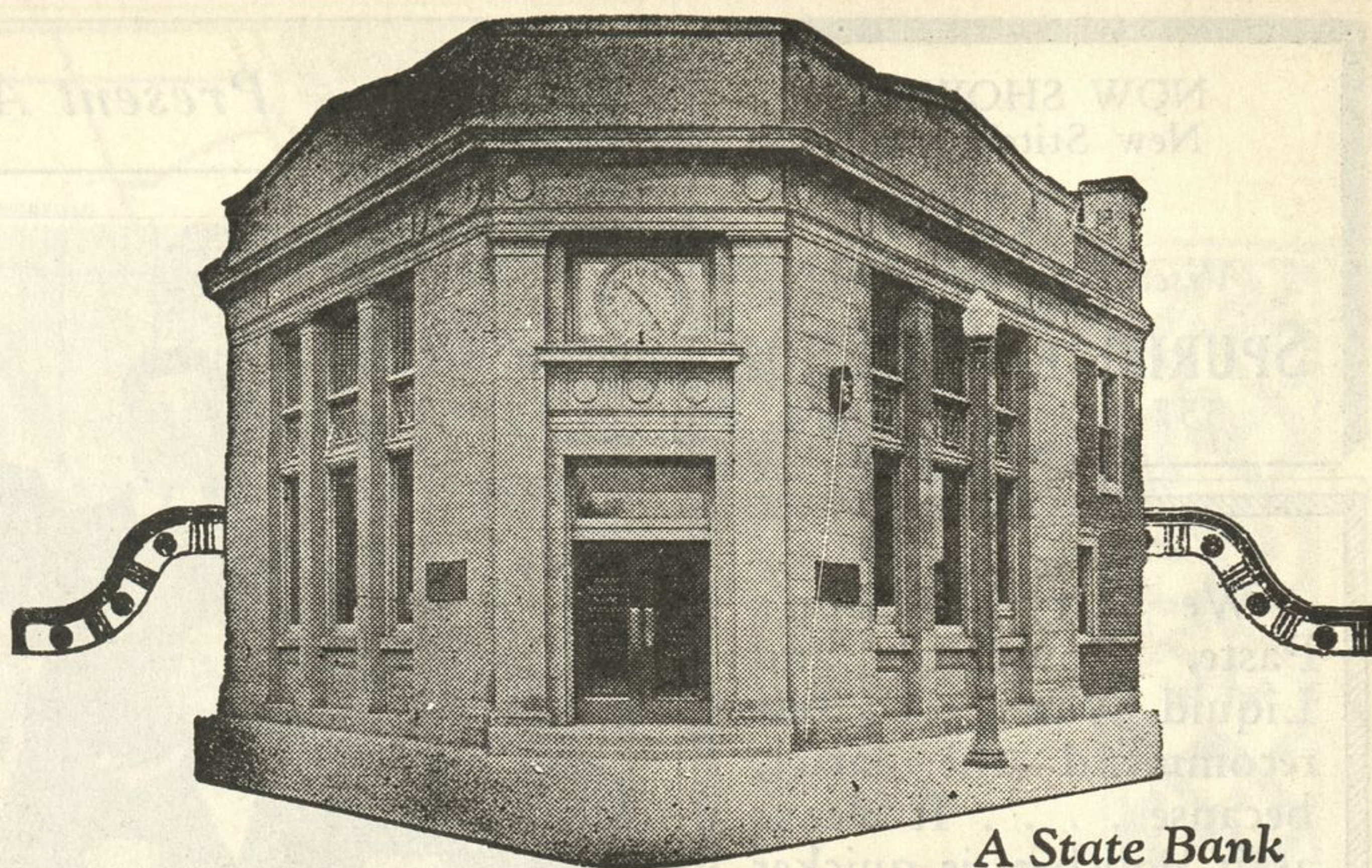

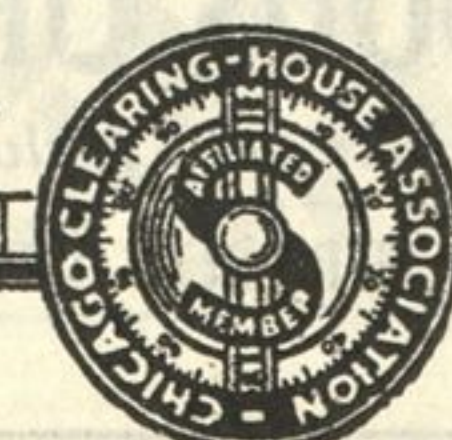
