His success in Wilmington has been noteworthy and he has endeared himself to the entire city. One of the features of his pastorate was radio broadcasting of the Sunday night service. Dr. Allison was president of the Baptist State Convention of Delaware for four years, was elected grand chaplain of the Masons, also chaplain of the Kiwanis club, and also has held many other community and state honors.

Mrs. Allison, who has always been prominent in girls' and women's work in the church, is a graduate of the New York State College for Teachers. The family consists of two boys, ages 11 and 4.

The members of the Wilmette Baptist church are very much delighted over the prospect of Dr. Allison's pastorship.
