


Wilmette Mission Leader Named Head of School in India

Rev. Bryan S. Stoffer, the representative in India of the First Congregational church of Wilmette, has just been appointed president of the American college in Madura, India, according to a cable received this week at the American Board of Commissioners for Foreign Missions. This is a signal honor in that Mr. Stoffer is a young American who has been serving in India only since 1923, not having yet completed his first term (seven years) as a foreign missionary. He was born in Georgetown, Ohio, and educated at Ashland and Oberlin colleges. Just prior to sailing for India in 1923 he received his Ph.D. from the University of Chicago.

The college, to the presidency of which Mr. Stoffer has just been appointed, was founded by the American board in 1842 and is one of the earliest mission schools of supervised secondary education in Madura, South India.

Stapp, general convention director. Assignments are being made by the bureau on receipt of an agreed deposit, equal to the first day's charge.


