"GOD'S FOOLS"—SERMON

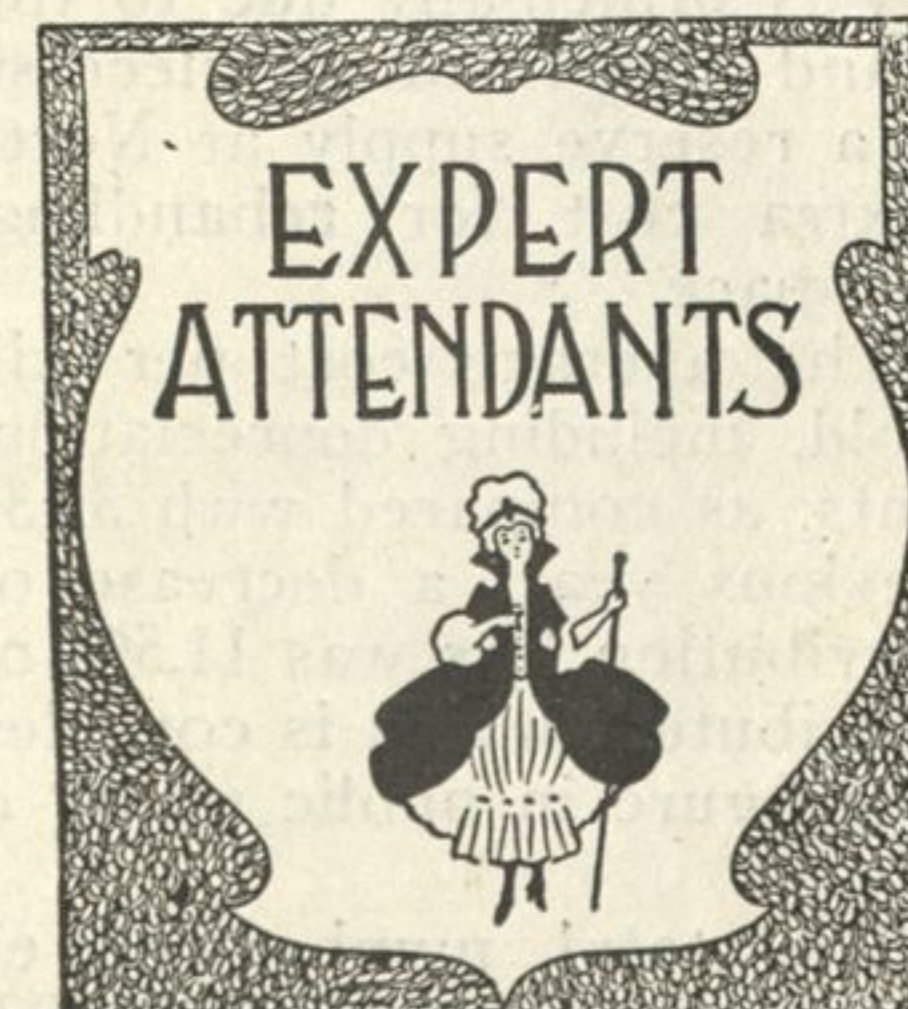
