The group of boys will be on their way to the 18-day camping expedition Monday, June 18. They will go by rail to Milwaukee and by boat from that point to Ludington from whence the motor bus will take them into camp several miles away.

For nearly three weeks these youngsters will know the joy of the out-of-doors, the freedom of the great open spaces, the mystery of the northern forests. Paul Reynolds, Ayres Boal, Jr., and one other, to be announced later.

The boys arrive home from camp Saturday morning, July 7. A group of girl campers leaves for camp Monday, July 9.

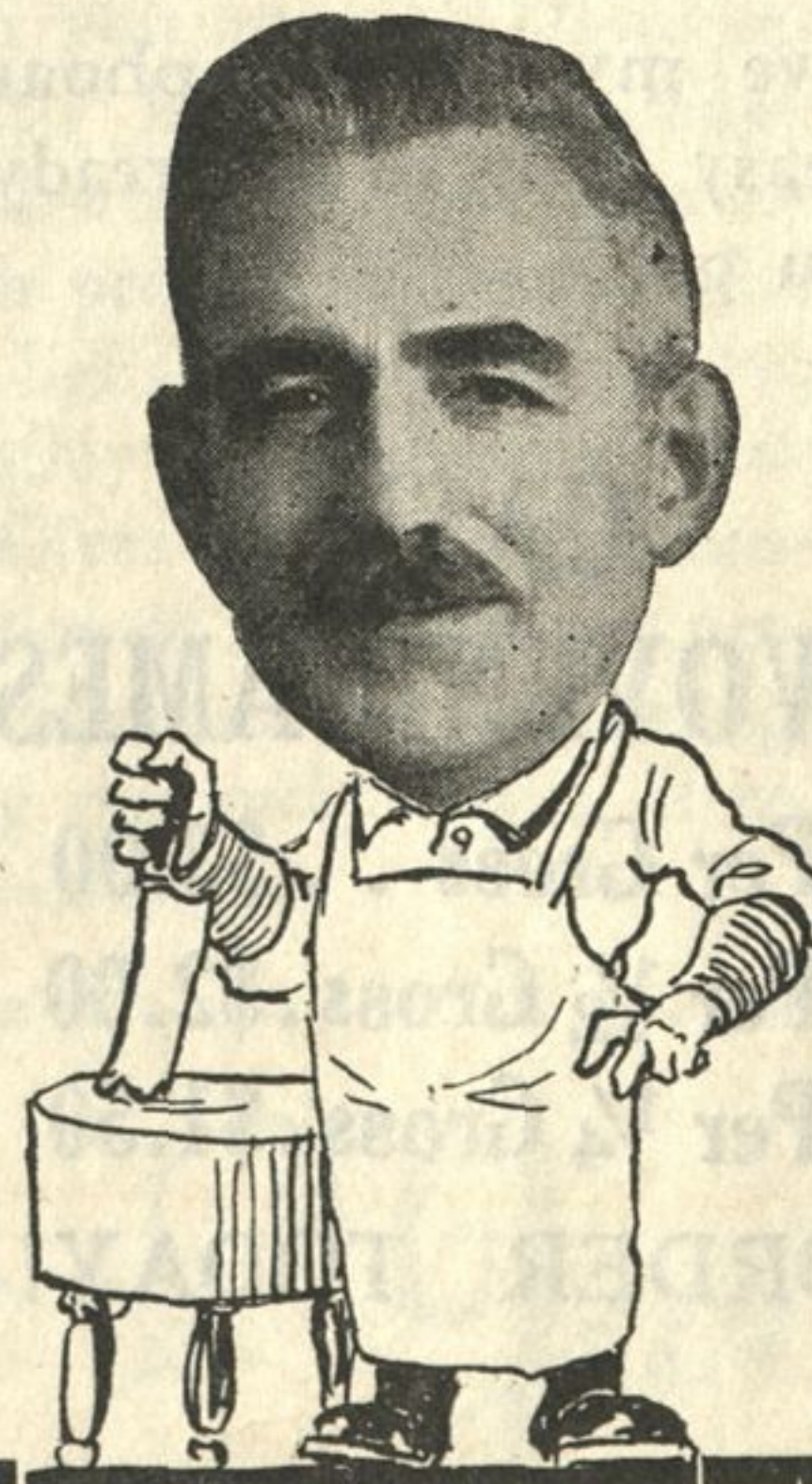
