10:30-11:10—Girl non-swimmers. Under ten years: Monday and Thursday. Ten years and over: Tuesday and Friday.

11:15-11:55 — Ladies. Beginners: Monday and Thursday. Swimmers: Tuesday and Friday.

12:00-12:40—Boys who pass test. Under ten years: Monday and Thursday. Ten years and over: Tuesday and Friday.

Advanced classes on Wednesday. Girls at 9 o'clock. Ladies at 10:00. Boys at 11:00. These classes are arranged for members of the regular classes who are able to do advanced swimming and diving.

Anyone who wishes to enter one of the swimming classes should register in the main office of the high school any week day from 8:30 to 12 o'clock.

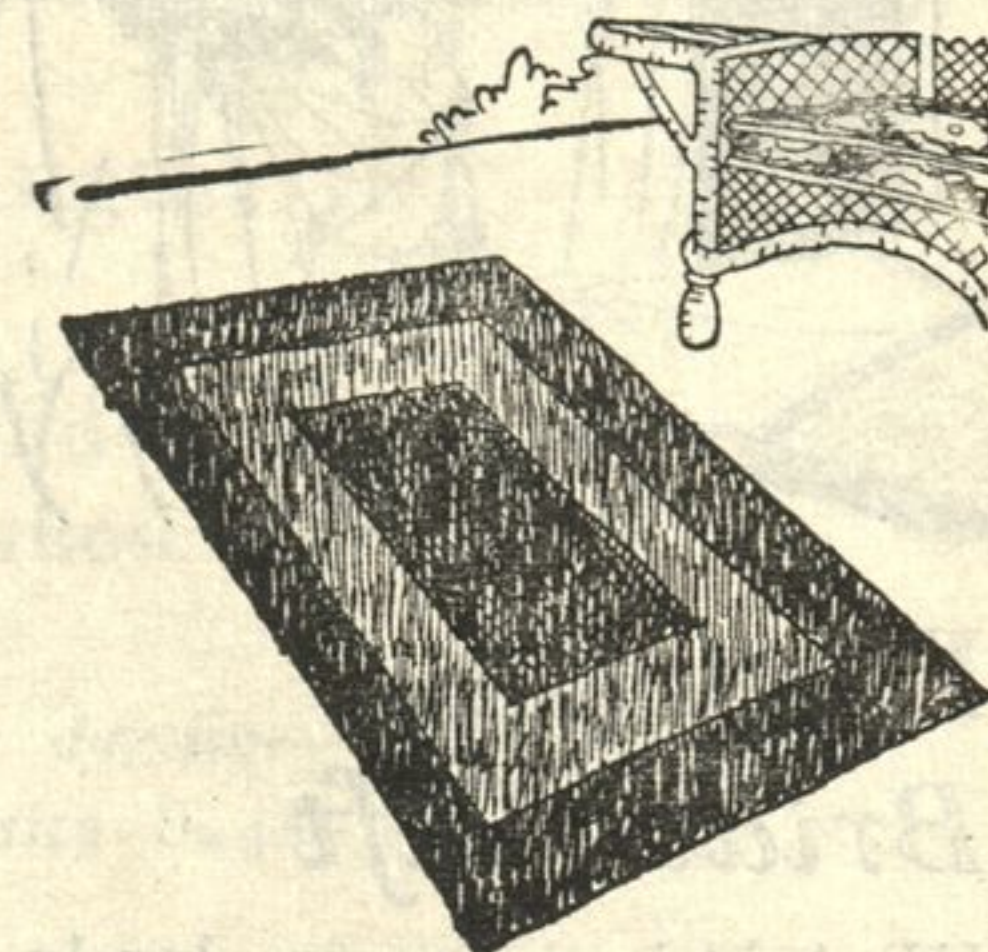

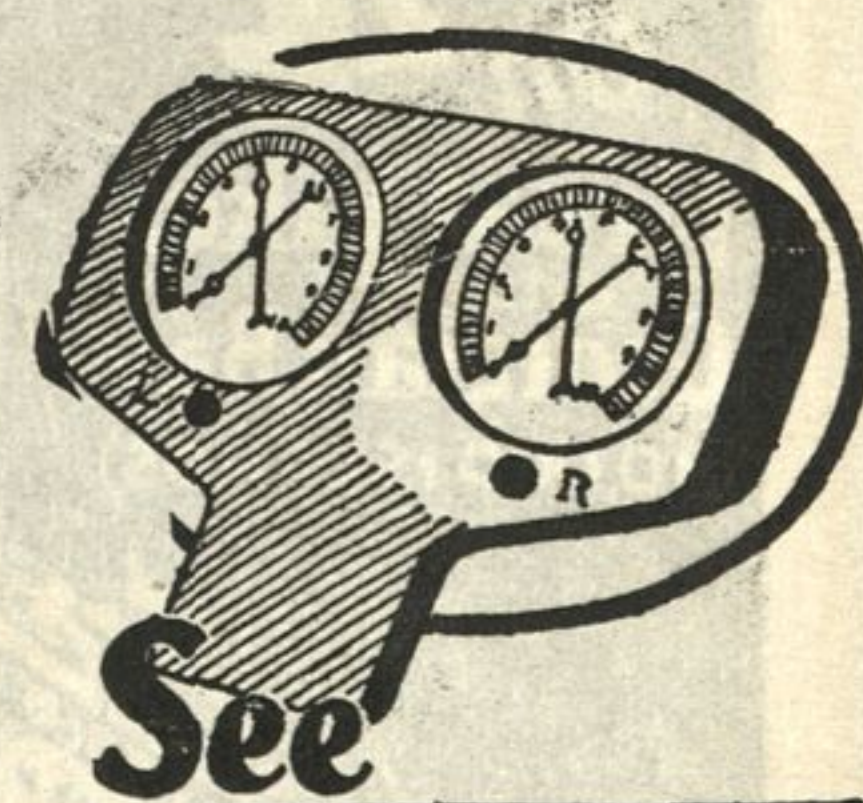

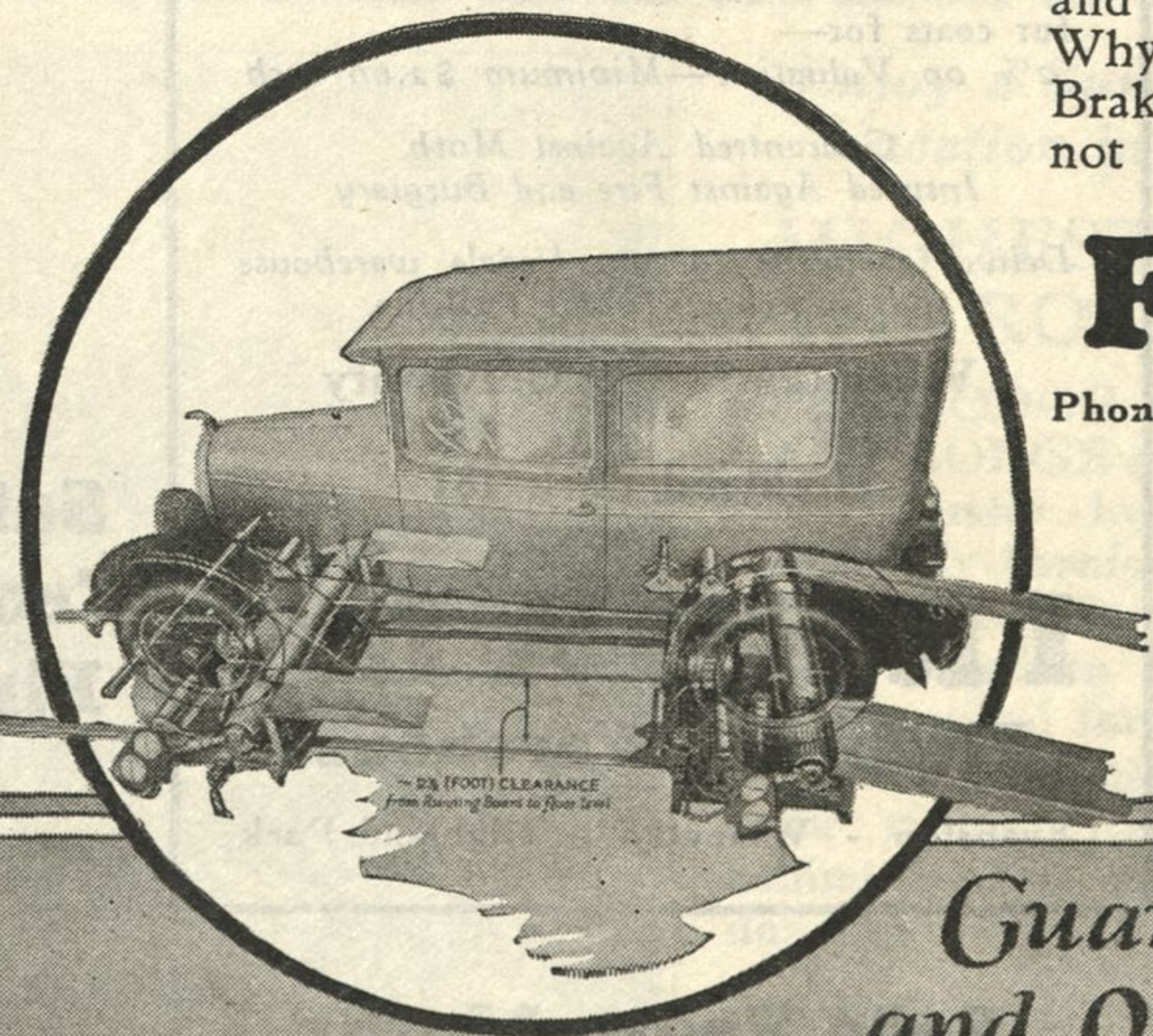
