of white muslin, cut perfectly straight and smooth, with lace edges, 95c. Sizes 2 to 4.



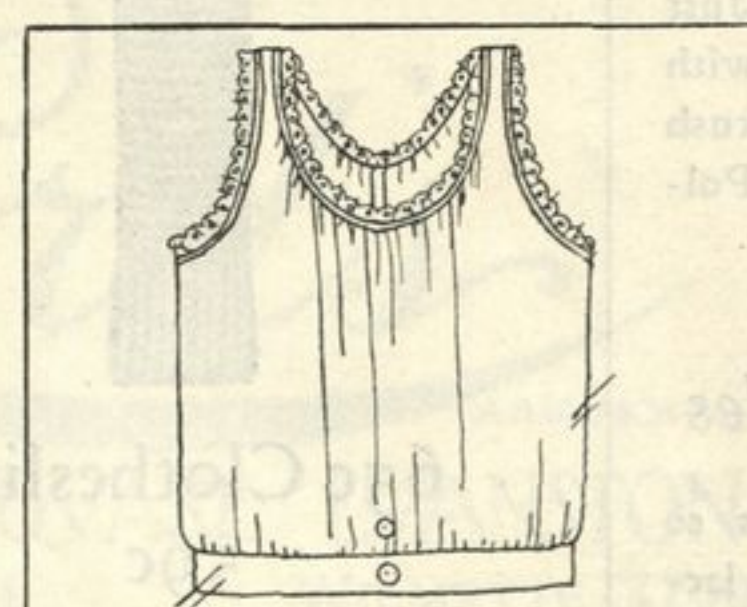
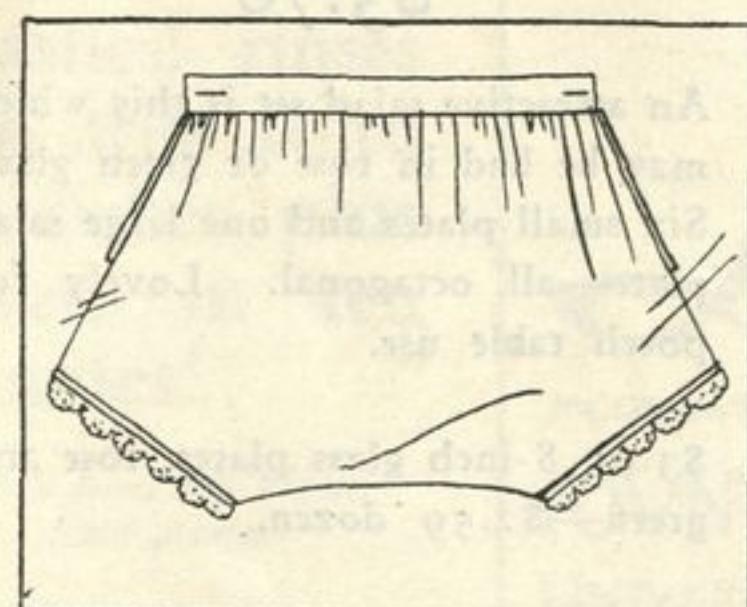
French Combination

French jersey—in cardigan style with three buttons—in petal pink, French blue, white, emerald, and gold,

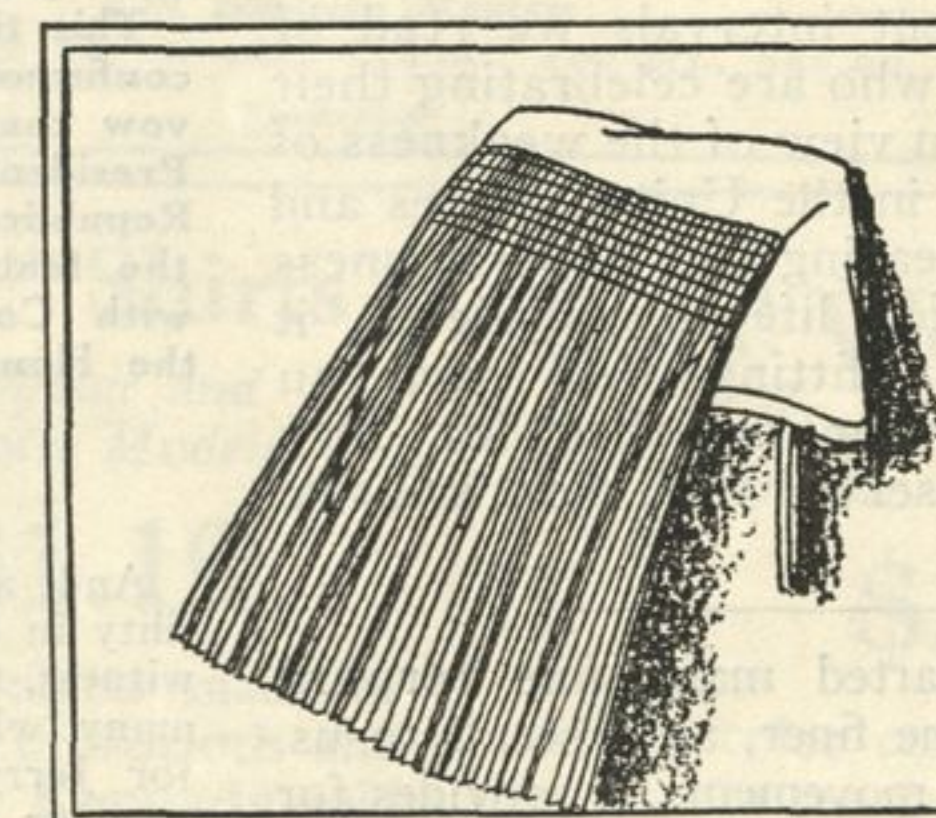
