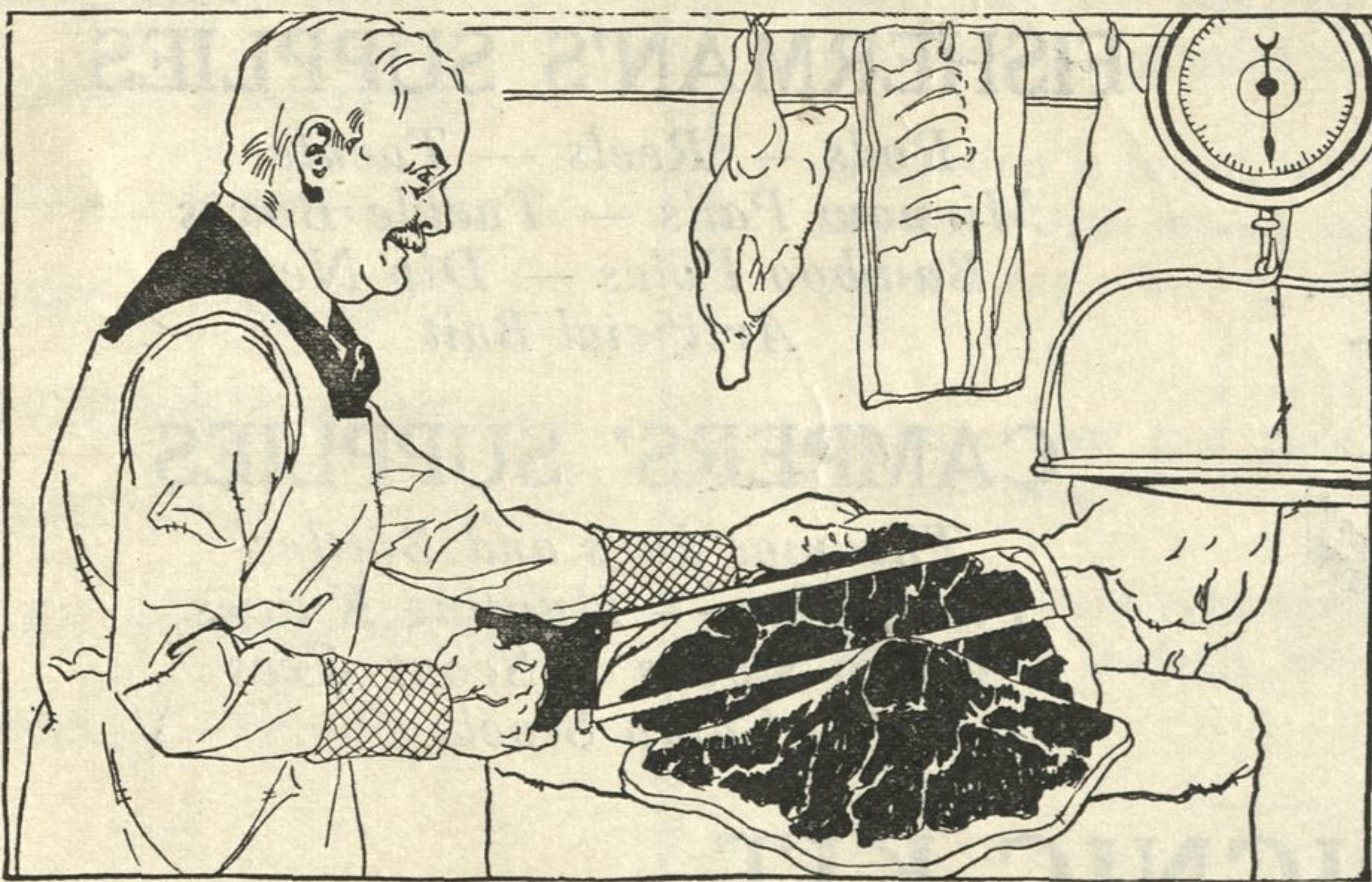
Mr. Cushman during the last ten years has done some beautiful landscaping and his Japanese sunken garden is one of the show gardens of the Chicago district.
