

### Court Permits North Shore to Operate Over "L" Track

The right of the Chicago, North Shore and Milwaukee railroad to operate passenger and merchandise despatch cars over the elevated lines of the Chicago Rapid Transit company has been established in a decision handed down by the Illinois Supreme Court.

The Supreme court held that the Superior court of Cook county erred in issuing an injunction asked by the city of Chicago restraining the operation of North Shore line cars south of Irving

Park boulevard, and it reversed and remanded the order with directions to grant the relief asked for by the company.

After an extended review of the history of the case and the various city ordinances under which the elevated lines operate, the Supreme court held that the North Shore line had developed a large passenger business into and out of the city, that "the service has been a great convenience to the traveling public and to the people of the state and the city of Chicago, as well as the intervening municipalities between Chicago and Milwaukee; that

until the complaint made by the city on October 8, 1924, out of which this case has grown, no one entered any complaint against the service."

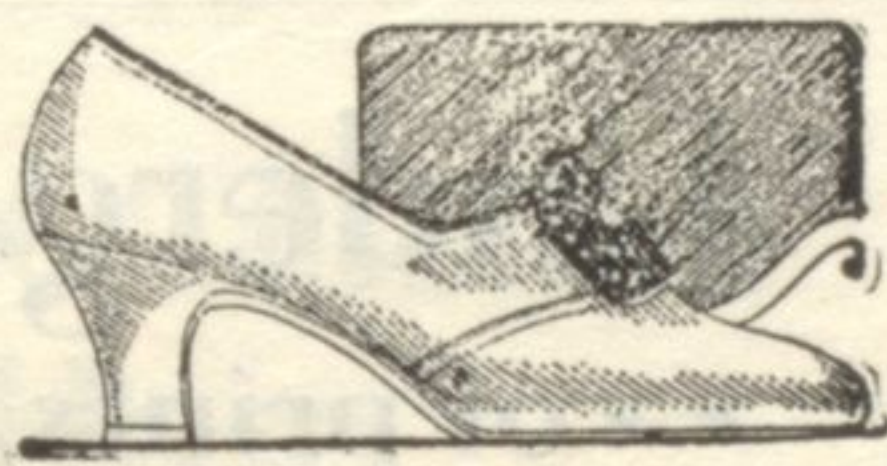
Play in the Net-Lo Medal event is scheduled for Sunday, July 8, as well as the final round in the Grounds' committee Trophy event for Classes C and D.
