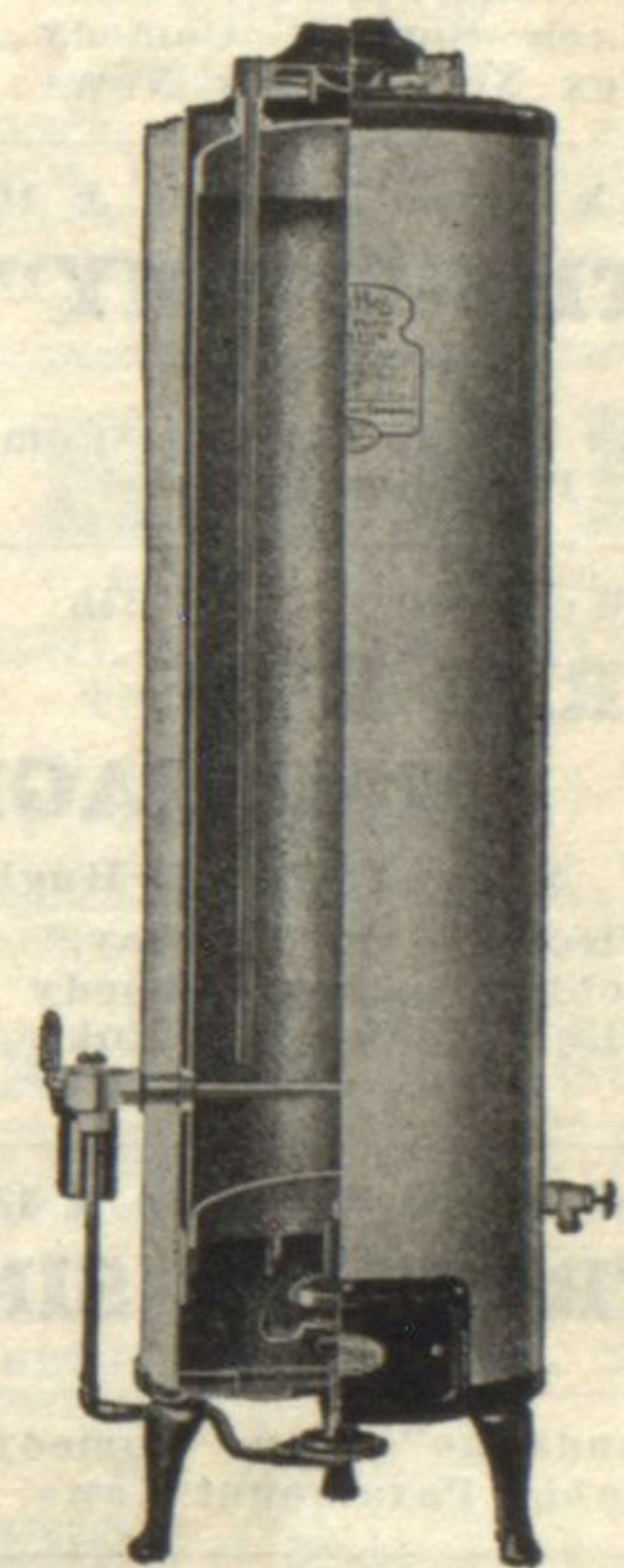

It is recommended by the United States Bureau of Standards as being a much better insulator than the commonly used asbestos.

The EverHot leakage by-pass, which prevents waste of gas due to dripping hot water faucets, will in itself save the price of the heater over a term of years. No other heater has it.
