The story was scenarized from the original play and set in elaborate replicas of Austrian cities constructed at the studios.

"Three Ring Marriage," to be shown at the Teatro next Wednesday, July 11, is a starring vehicle for Mary Astor and Lloyd Hughes, one of the most popular romantic combinations the screen offers. It is a tale of young love and jealousy, and it takes its participants from ranch to circus, finishing with a grand melodramatic flourish striped with comedy that leaves everybody happy but the smooth customer who doesn't deserve to be. Alice White, Lawford Davidson, and Yola d'Avril are also in the picture.
