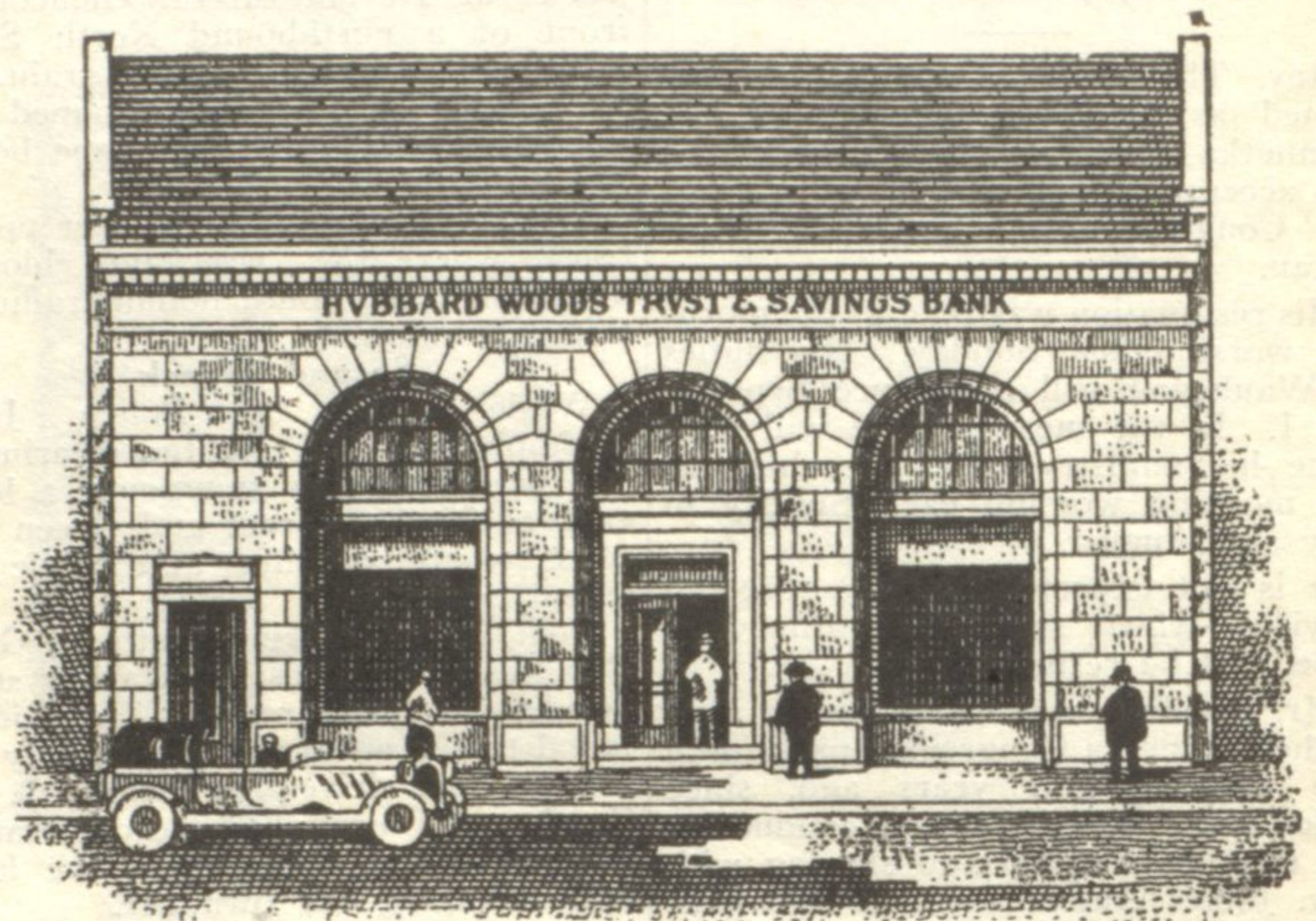
TO SEE OLYMPIC GAMES
