TIRE BILLS REDUCED
The average motorist's tire bill, at the present time, is costing him but 62.2 per cent of what he paid for tires one year ago, according to a survey just announced by the Automobile Club of Illinois. The average factory price for balloon tires in June was \$11,384, compared with \$14,045 in June a year ago. The factory price of cord tires was \$8,806 in June of this year, compared with \$10,948 in June, 1927. Fabric tires in June sold for \$5.31, compared with \$7,199 in June of last year, the Association's figures show.

Speedy Greasing System to Be Used by Wersted Motors
The rapid increase of automobiles in Winnetka, making necessary more rapid and efficient tuning is resulting in the installation by the Wersted Motors company, Winnetka and Glen-coe Dodge dealers, of a new and speedier system of greasing cars. Accidents to Children Often Due to Car Doors
Several serious accidents have been reported during the first six months of the year involving cases where children have fallen out of machines due to extreme carelessness on the part of the motorist, according to President Mayer of The Automobile Club of Illinois.
A child should not be allowed to sit next to the door of an automobile, nor extended such privileges as closing or opening the doors for passengers. In this wise many doors, which would otherwise seem securely fastened have merely been closed without the double-snap lock taking hold.
