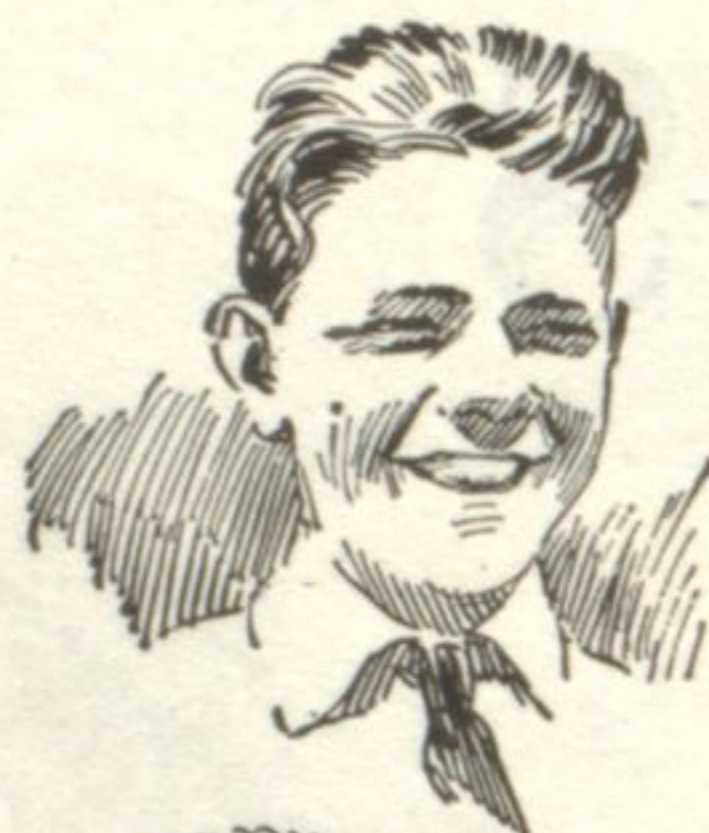
Milan Lusk to Resume Teaching Next Month

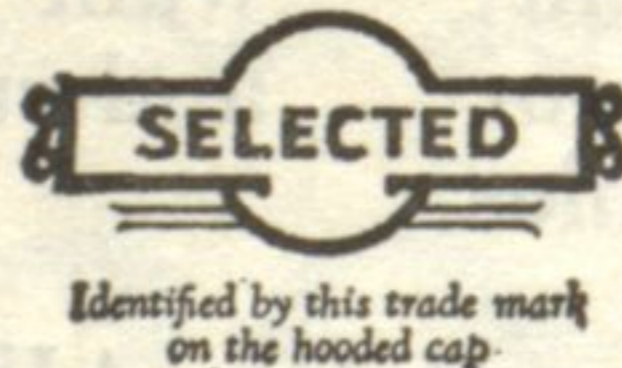
