

U. of C. Football Prospects Loom Quite Favorable

Priority applications for the 1928 football games of the University of Chicago will close September 13, the Football Tickets committee has announced. Rebuilding of Stagg Field last year brought the total seating capacity to 60,000, new steel stands eliminating the old wooden bleachers. Of the total capacity, 30,000 seats are available for the general public.

Coach A. A. Stagg will be directing the Maroon team for the thirty-seventh season this year. Prospects indicate a better team than that of last year, which broke even in its eight game schedule. Backfield material on the Midway is of better quality than in recent years, and the interesting open game that the Maroons played last year will be more evident, because more passing and running backs will be on the squad.

Priority is given in location to season applications for the eight games which will be played at Stagg Field. The first two dates will have two games on the same afternoon. Over 20,000 of the public seats are on the sidelines, and these will be distributed

first among season ticket holders. Applications for individual games also will be filled, following the allotment of season books. One and two-seat applications will be filled first, but any number of books may be ordered.

The schedule brings three inter-sectional rivals to Stagg Field, including Pennsylvania, Wyoming and South Carolina. Illinois, Iowa and Purdue are conference teams which play on the Midway.

October 6—Wyoming; Lake Forest.
October 13—Iowa.
October 27—Purdue.
November 3—Pennsylvania.
November 17—Illinois.

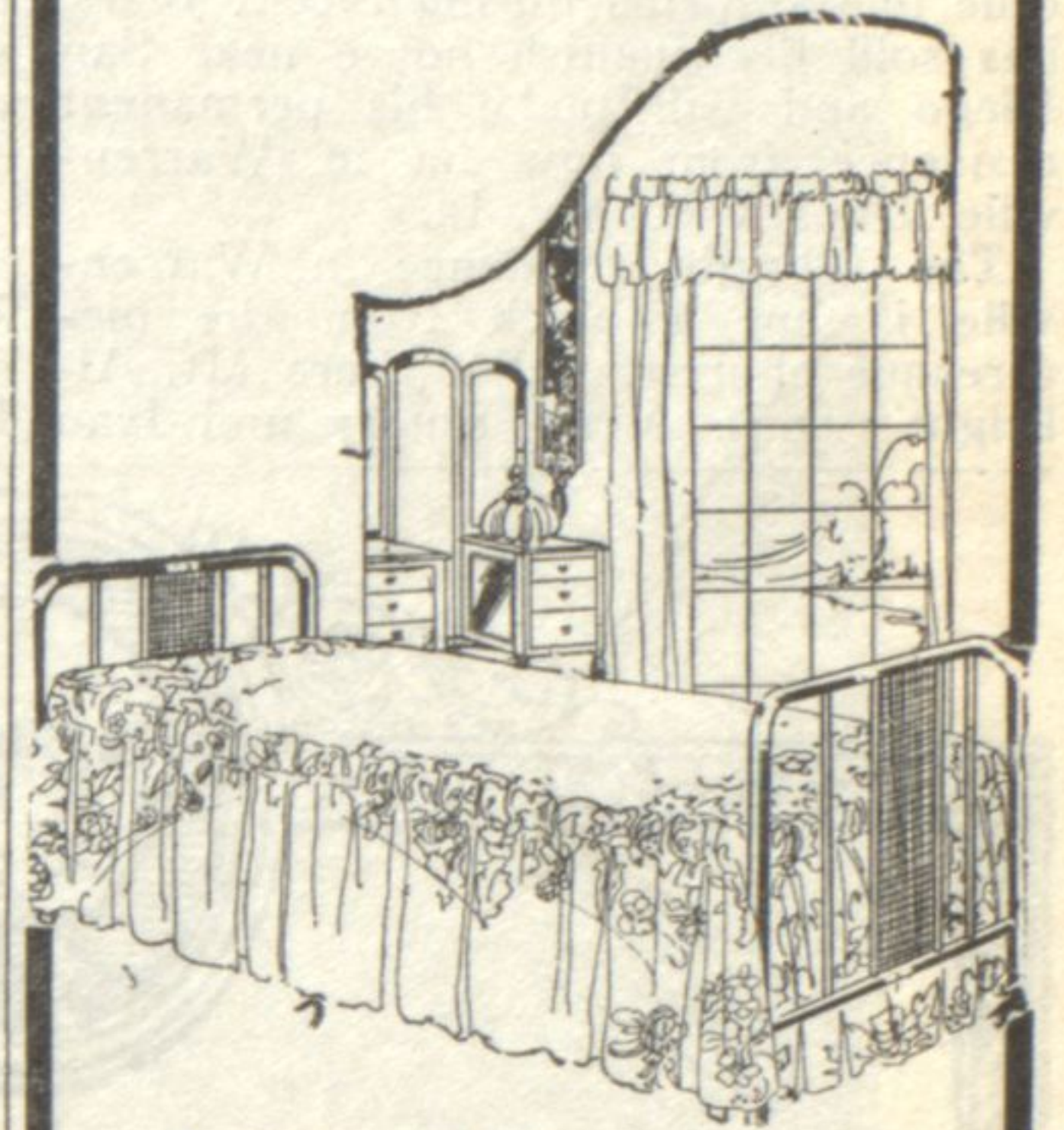

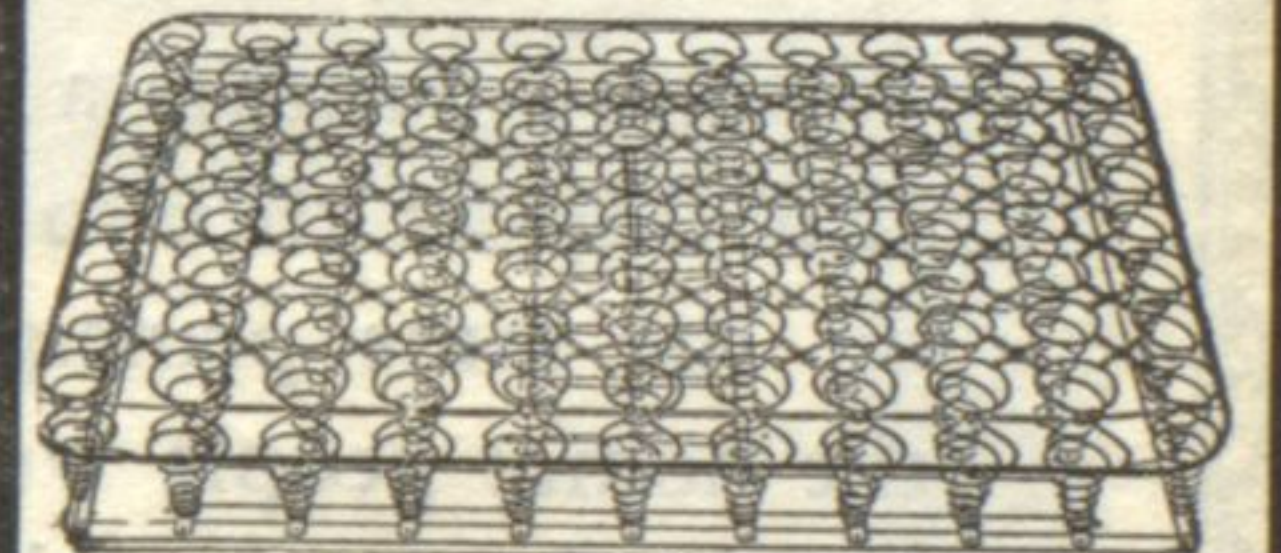

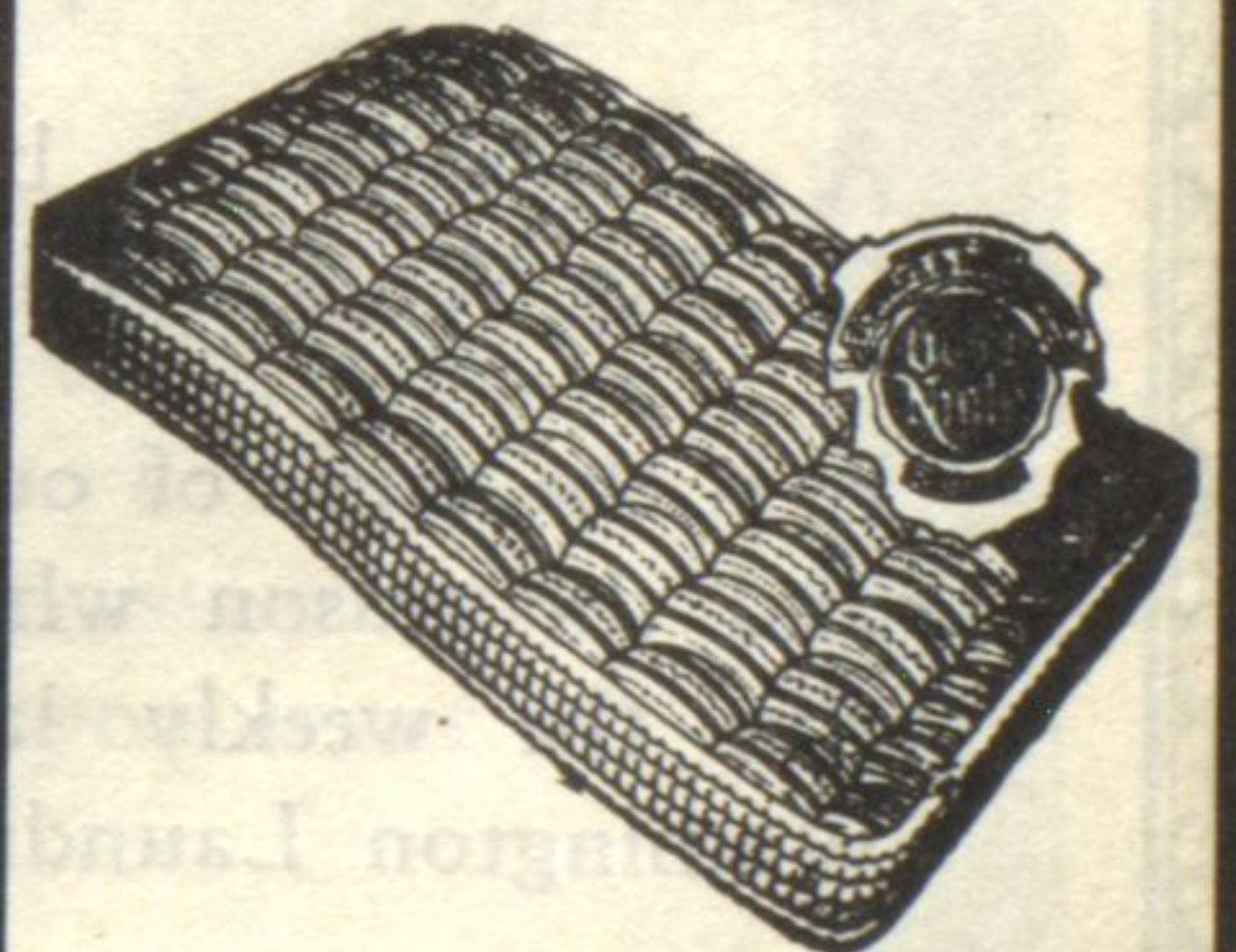
