May Widen Street Intersection to Minimize Hazard

Village Manager H. L. Woolhiser has been authorized by the Village council to take immediate action, in the matter of reducing the danger to traffic, particularly pedestrians, at Lake street and Scott avenue, where a serious accident occurred a short time ago.

In the meantime more deliberate consideration by the council will be given to a plan of widening the streets at this intersection. The removal of some trees and shrubs on the parkway are steps which it was said the village manager may take now, pending the consideration of a street widening project.

The matter was brought to the attention of the council in the form of a petition presented by Arthur Burrage Farwell which contained signatures of sixty interested property owners.

The proposed permanent improvement was referred to the streets, drainage and forestry committee, of which Trustee H. L. Raclin is chairman.
