Mail Out 13,000 Season Tickets for Purple Games

Thirteen thousand season ticket books for Northwestern university's football games this fall were mailed out to purchasers this Friday, according to announcement from the Northwestern ticket office.

This allotment of season ticket books, which is the largest in the history of the university, was filled by a large corps of workers and all were placed in the mails at the same time. Orders for these tickets have been received since the sale opened last April.

Orders for season books received after the above allotment has been mailed will be delivered as the order is received. It is expected that the season ticket sale will reach 15,000 this fall. The games for which these tickets are good are Butler, Ohio, Kentucky, Minnesota, Purdue and Dartmouth.

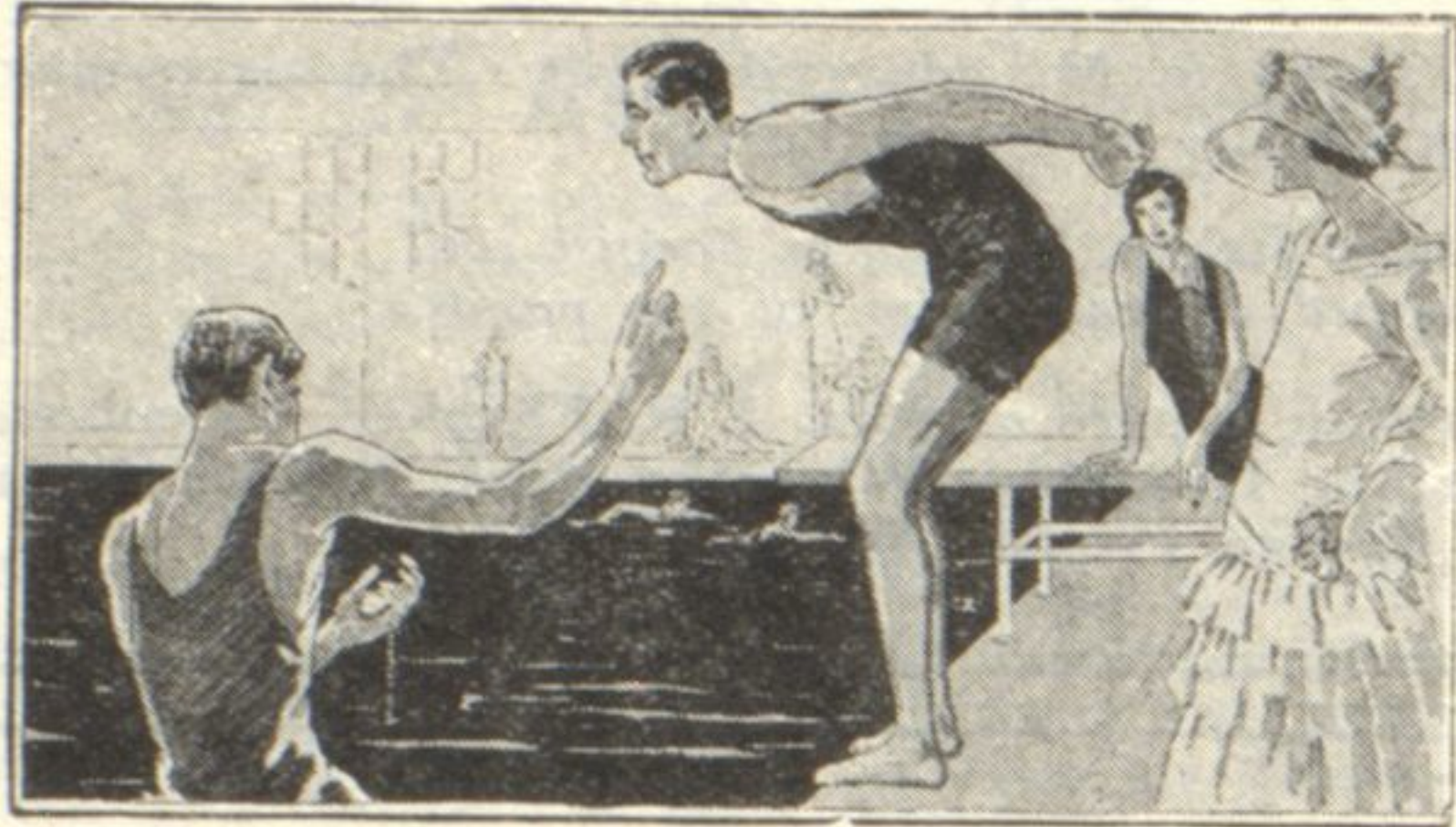
