but it provides a suitable framework for a succession of original gags, dramatic situations, and hilarious moments.

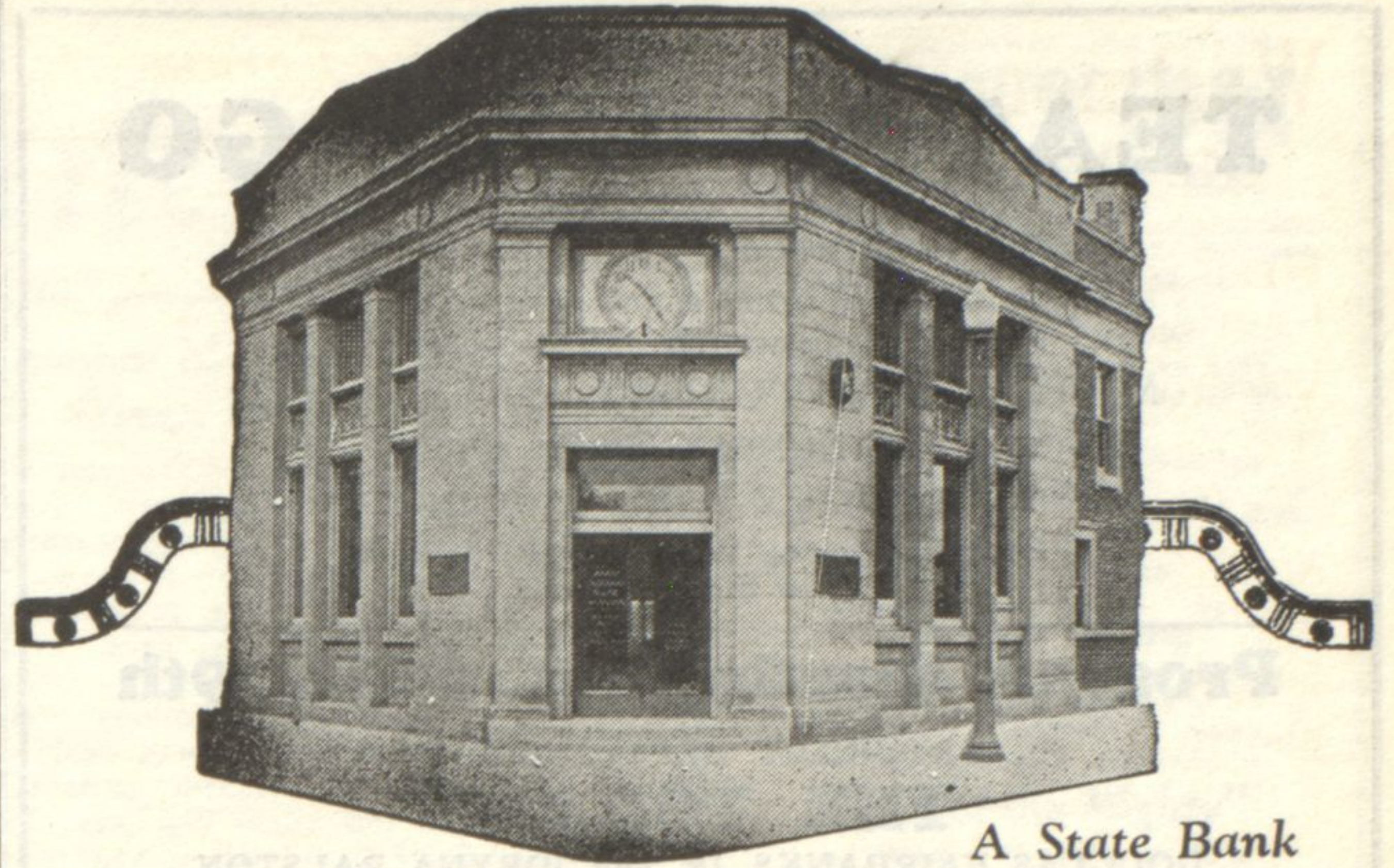

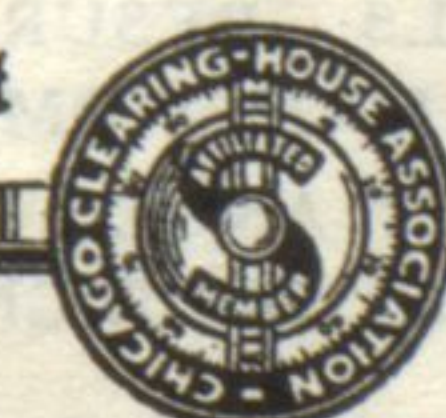
