The proper care of sterling silver is really an easy matter Remember that it is solid; it will not wear off; therefore, use it as much as possible-no better method of cleaning has ever been found.

Flat wear tarnishes less if it is kept in a rack in a dining-room drawer which is well brushed out from time to time.

Wash sterling with a cloth in hot soapy water, rinse thoroughly in clear hot water, and wipe dry with an absorbent dish towel while the pieces are still warm. Constant use and washing will effectually prevent tarnish.

Sterling properly handled seldom needs polishing. Once a month or on a special occasion a quick rubbing with a reliable polishing liquid restores the brilliancy and lustre.

Never clean flat silver by boiling with aluminum or soap solution except under definite directions from your jeweler.
