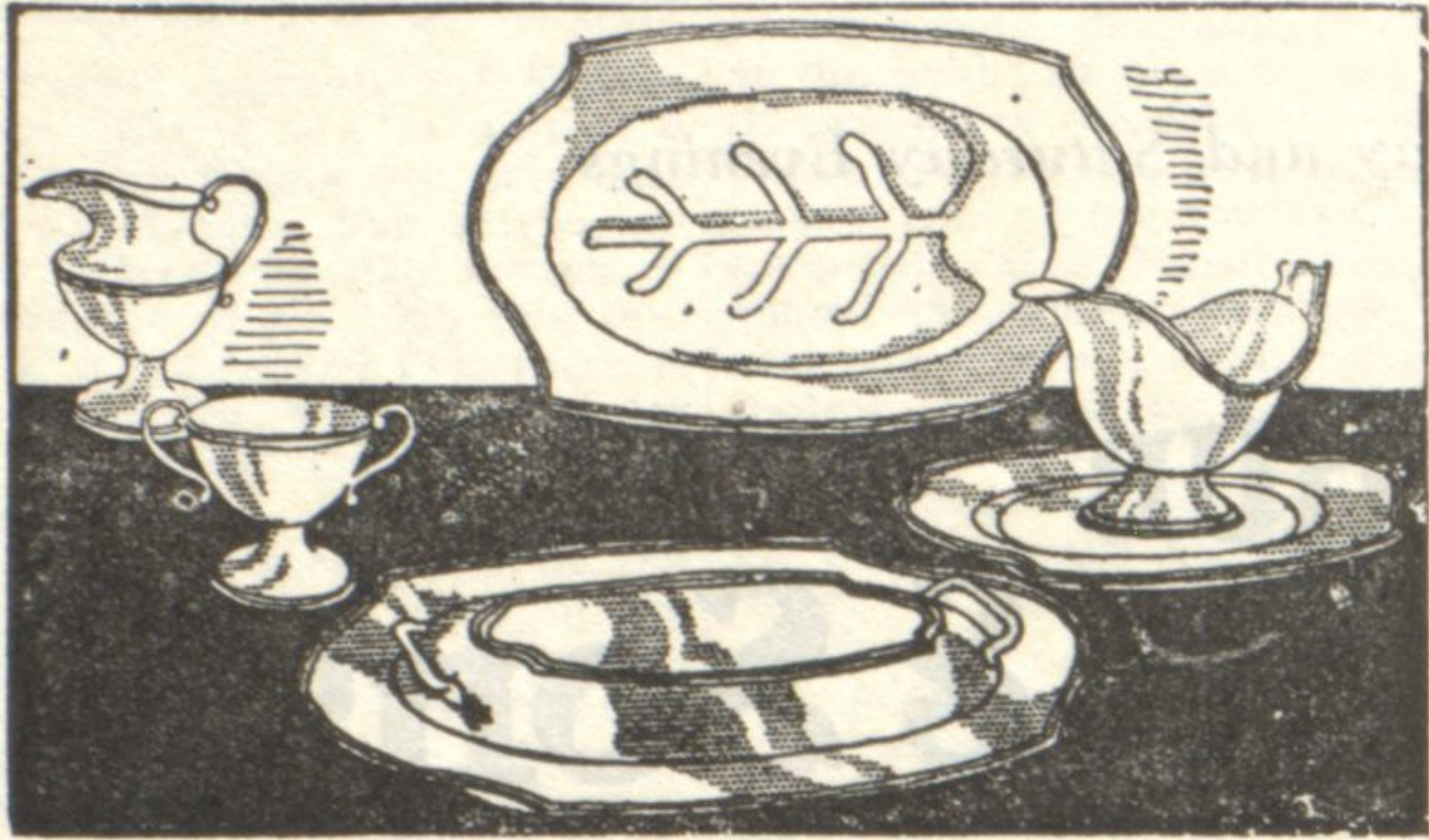

The regular monthly meeting of the voting members of the congregation will be held on Tuesday evening next at 7:45 o'clock. At this meeting the new slate of candidates will be presented, since the election of officers of the congregation is to take place in the December meeting. A full report on the services of October 21 to 26 will also be rendered. All voting members are urged to be there without fail.

## Kellogg Treaty Subject of Uptown Forum Sunday

"Shall We Ratify the Kellogg Treaty for Outlawing War?" will be the subject for discussion at the meeting of the Uptown Forum, Sunday evening, November 11. Dr. Frank Bohn of the New York Times, one of the highest authorities on international questions and one who has had intimate contact with nations and people all over the world, will review the facts and forces entering into the problem of prevention of war and give appraisal of the merits of the Kellogg plan. Another speaker to be announced will speak in criticism of the outlawry idea. The discussion by the speakers will be followed by the usual questions by the audience.

The Forum meets at the People's church, 941 Lawrence avenue, Sunday evening, at 8 o'clock.
