

Fine Imported Damask to grace the festive board

Much of the success of the Thanksgiving dinner depends on having linens of perfect sheen and richness. Here are a few noteworthy examples whose quality, as well as price, commends them to the discerning shopper:

White Damask Sets, \$29.50

Heavy, smooth, linen in an elaborate scroll and conventional design. 72x108 inch cloth, and 22x22 inch (dinner size) napkins. Both napkins and cloth are beautifully hemmed by hand.

At \$27.50 there is a spokestitched set with a 66x104 inch cloth and a dozen 22-inch napkins. Daisy, rose and scroll design.

When dishwashing time comes you want firm, absorbent towels that will help the drying. White, silver-bleached linen—bordered all around in orchid, gold, red or green. \$6.25 dozen.

Pure linen, with hand-featherstitched hems, and elaborate hand-embroidery, done in colors in the corners. Cloth and 4 napkins, \$3.50. A variety of patterns and colors.

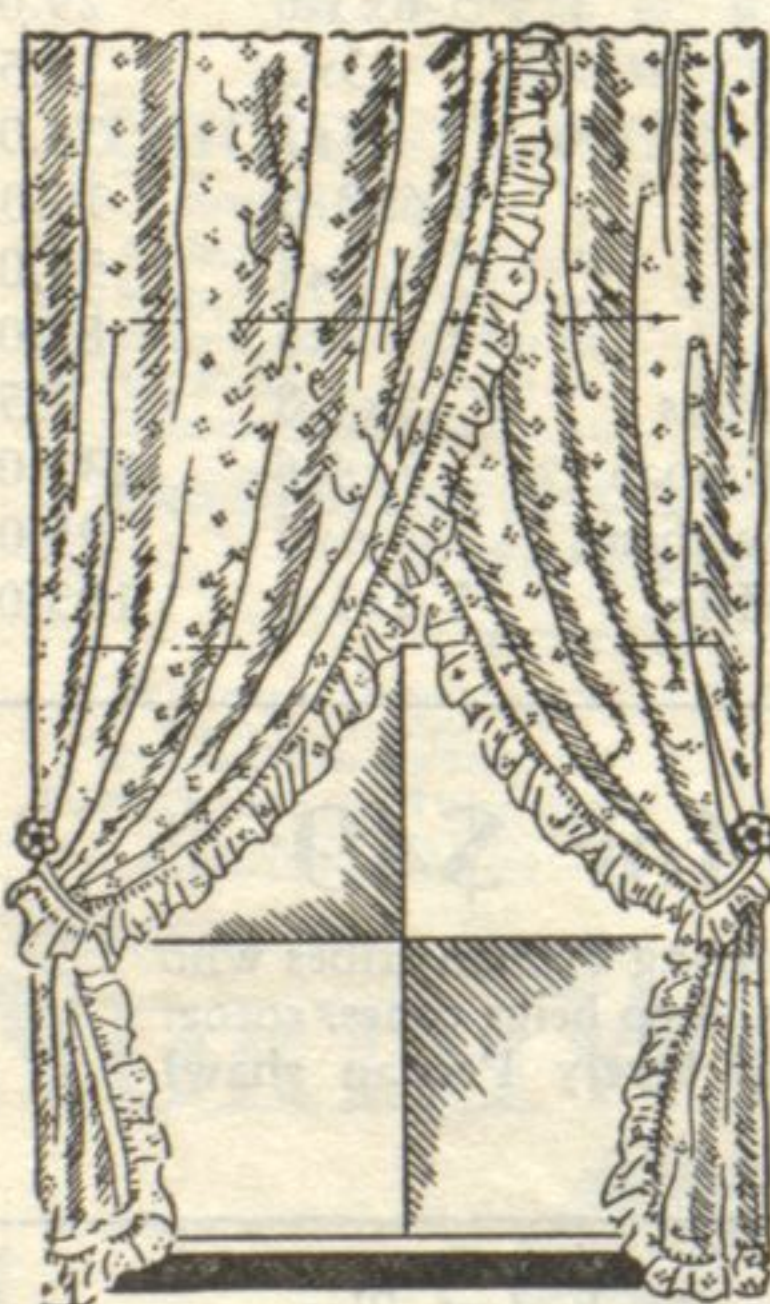
Separate Damask Napkins

Juicy-Krisp Roasters

A SELF BASTING ROASTER with steamer tray that keeps the meat juicy and browns it crisp. For a 10 pound turkey, \$4.25; for an 18 pound turkey \$4.50. Enamelled in white, gray, yellow, red and green.

AN INEXPENSIVE OVAL ROASTER finished in blue speckled enamel. Easy to baste. For medium sized turkey, \$1.25. For large turkey, \$1.40.

A HEAVY ALUMINUM OVAL ROASTER of Lifetime ware. Self-basting with steamer tray, \$6.85.

PARING KNIFE OF STAINLESS STEEL. Red, blue, yellow and green handles, 25c.

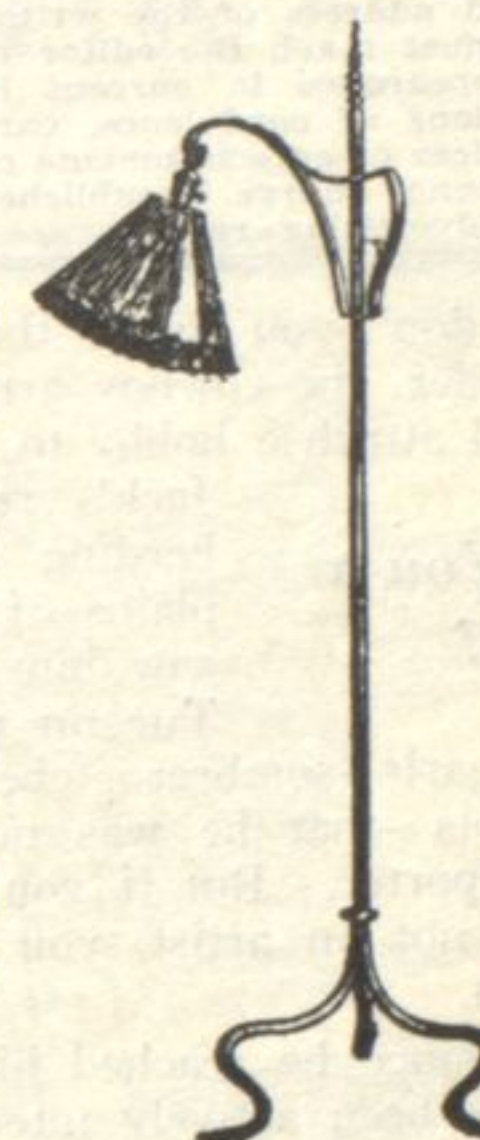
