


**"Dear Brutus," Sir James Barrie Comedy at Goodman**

**Restore West Land Tract to First Zoning**



A small portion of the area recently re-zoned from one-sixth acre "A" residential to one-half acre "A" residential, is to be restored to its former zoning, according to a resolution adopted by the Winnetka Village council, Tuesday evening. The small parcel referred to is located between Hibbard road and Berkeley avenue and Elm and Spruce streets. The heavy black sections in the foregoing cut embrace the entire area included in the one-half acre "A" residential zoning.

**Council Restores West Land Tract to First Zoning**

That section of Winnetka located between Hibbard road and Berkley avenue, Elm and Spruce streets, which was included in the territory recently re-

zoned from A residential or A one-sixth acre to A one-half acre area, is to be returned to its original classification, according to a resolution adopted at the meeting of the Village council Tuesday evening.

The action was taken on request of Sarah McD. Burlingham, owner of 1354 feet of the total street frontage

of 1854 feet. In her petition the owner sets forth that the property was re-zoned from class A residential to class A one-half acre, without her knowledge.

The owner also points out that the character of this propety does not warrant its classification with other property included in class A one-half acre.

The council's resolution, introduced by the Zoning committee, provides that an ordinance be drafted restoring the property in question to its former status, the ordinance to be referred to the Winnetka Zoning commission at the next meeting of that body.
