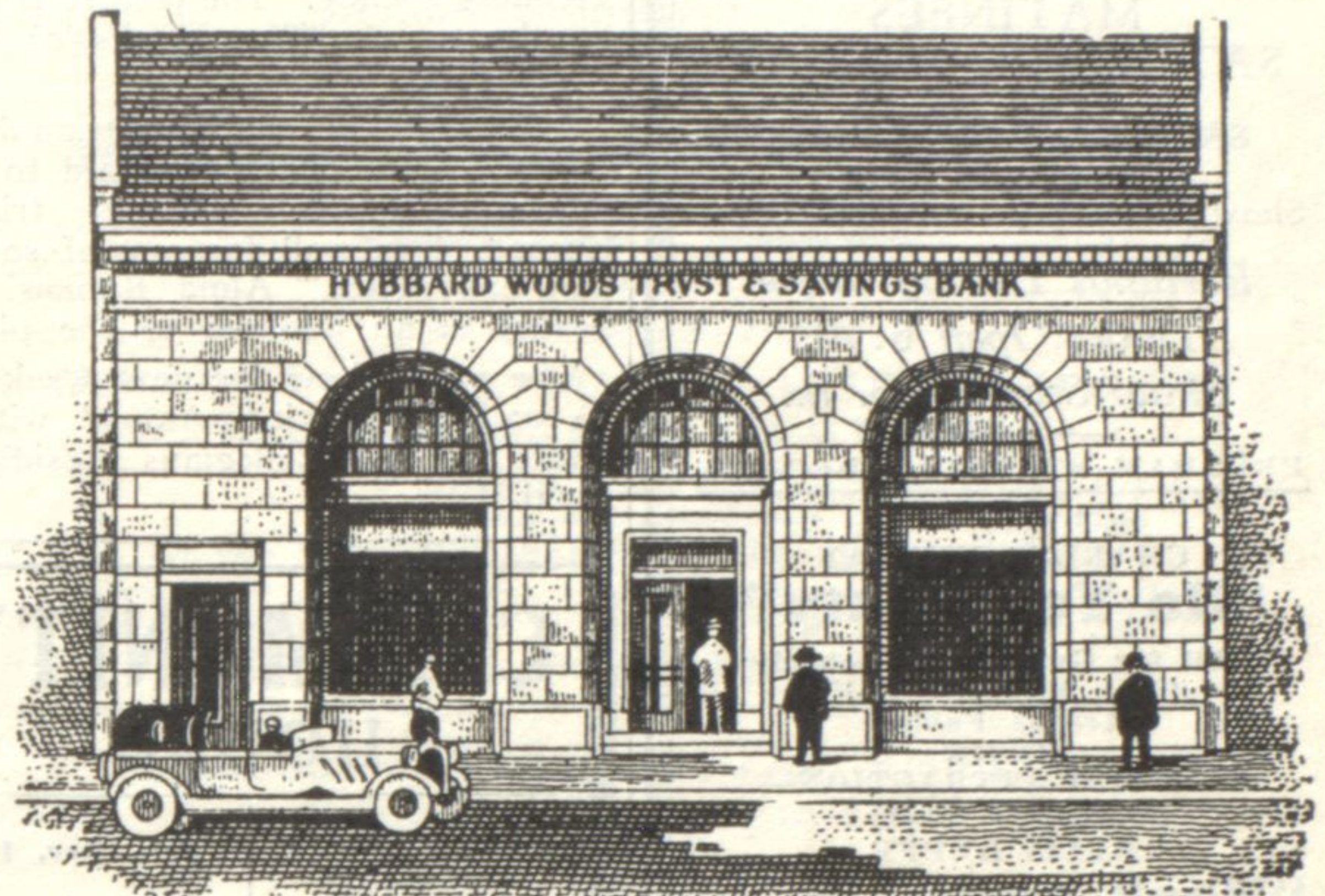
### John Mack Brown to Star in Naval Film at Granada
