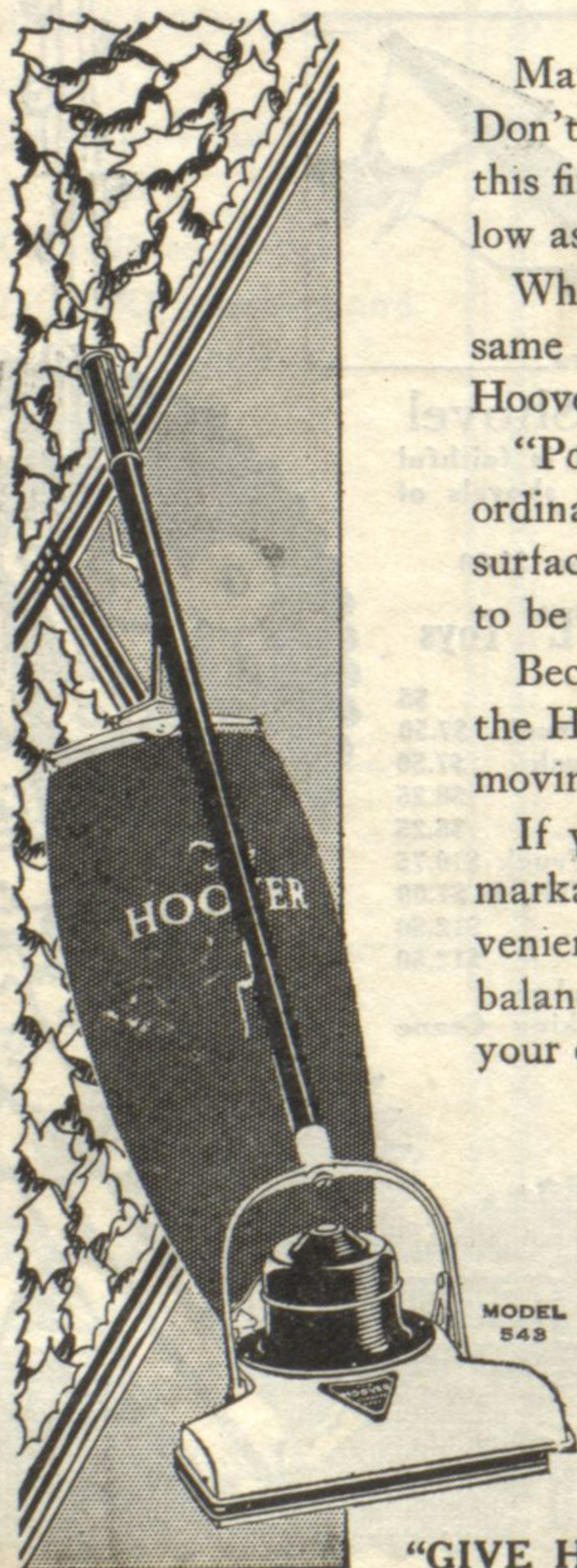
Christmas Seal Sale Nets \$34.99 at Hubbard Woods
