But after three appearances with the Chicago Symphony orchestra it was his first engagement without it, and twenty minutes after he had played his last number people still were cheering and applauding and refusing to go home."

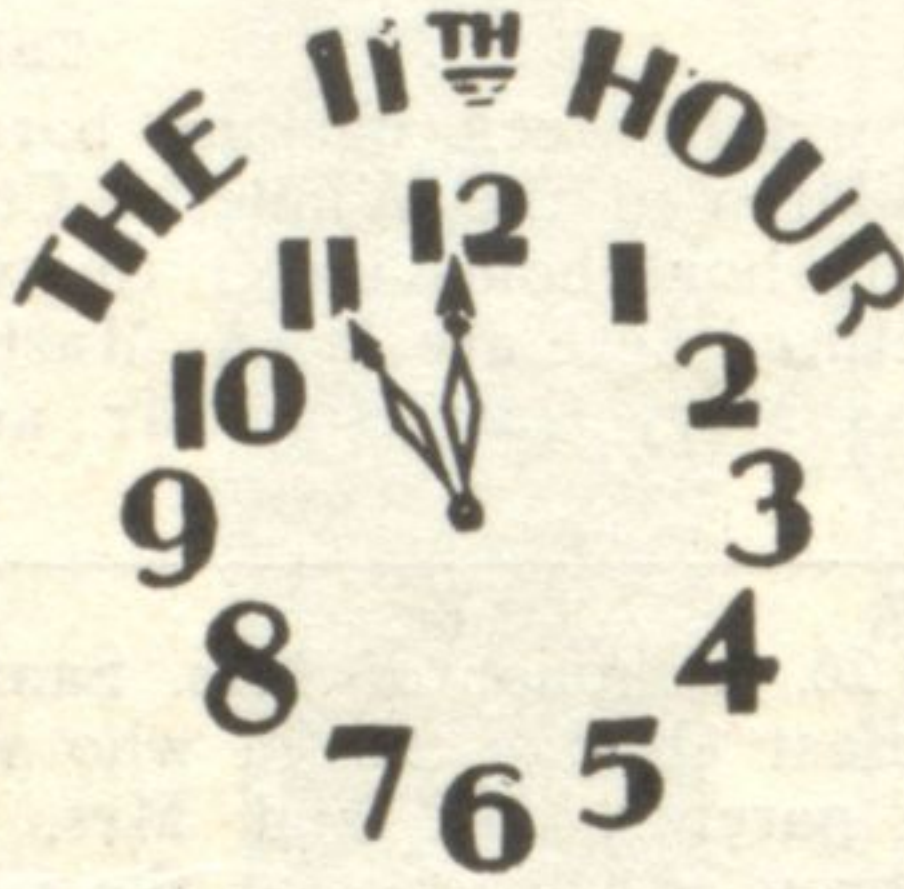

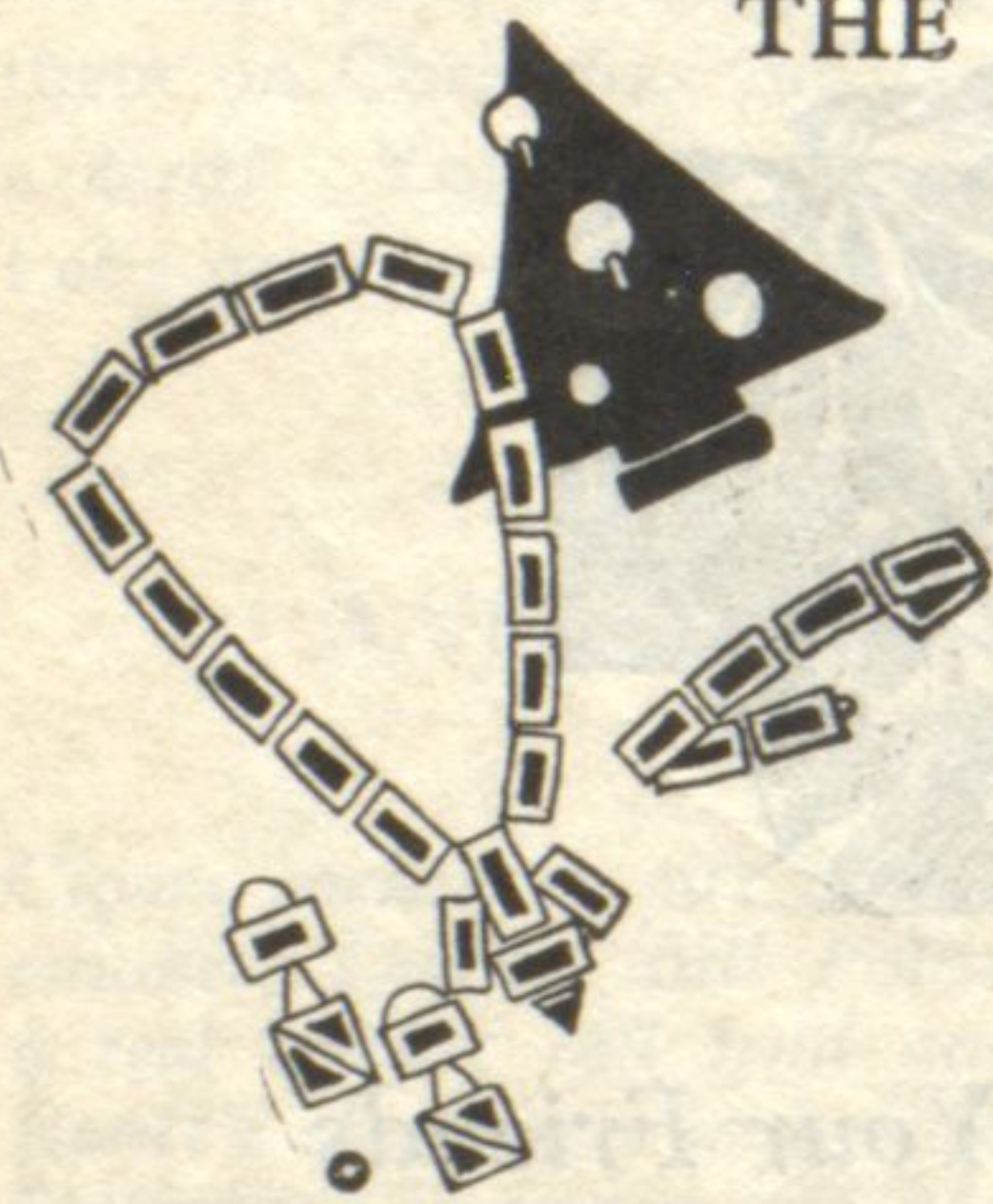

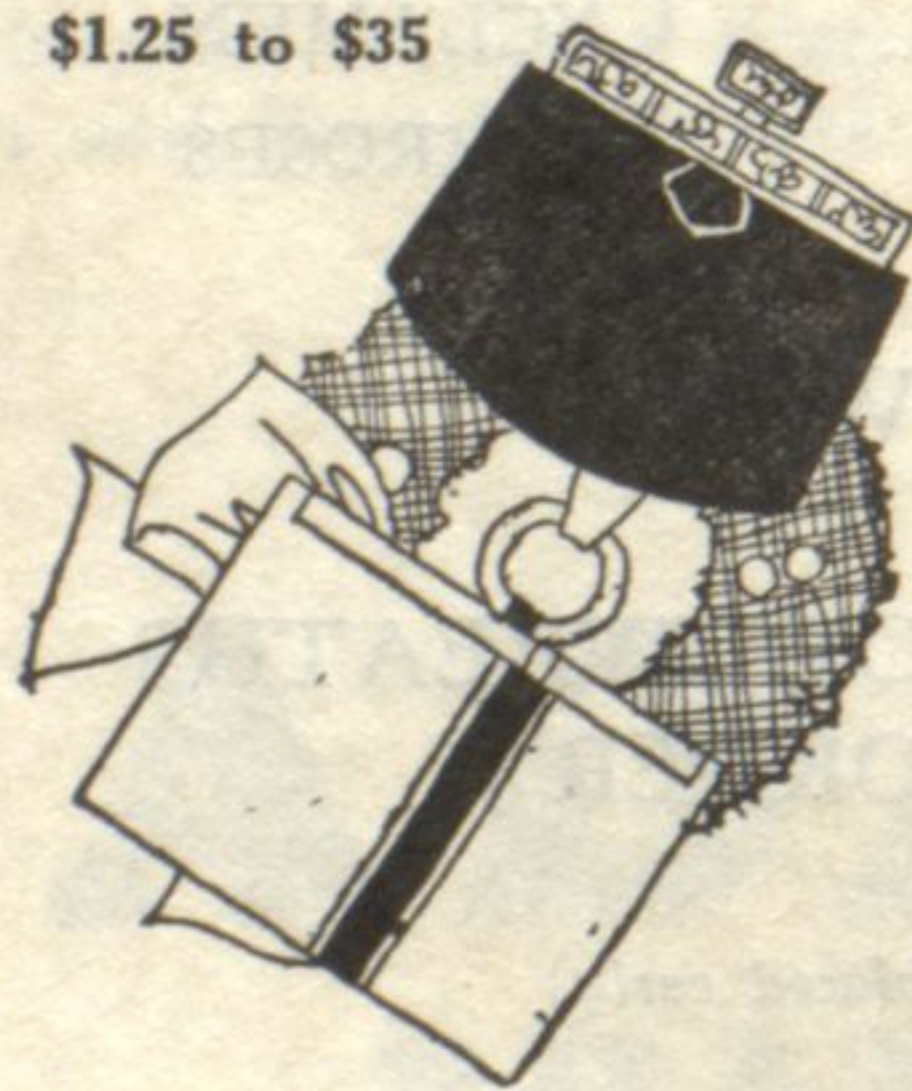
