

### Lake Bluff Zoning Law Given Jolt in High Court Ruling

A decision of great importance in the application of zoning principles has just been handed down by the Illinois Supreme Court at Springfield, in the case of David T. Bjork (a Chicago architect) vs. Safford, et al (constituting the Lake Bluff Zoning Appeal board).

The case arose in connection with an attack on the validity of one of the provisions of the Lake Bluff Zoning ordinance which prohibited the construction of any building, in a district which was zoned for apartments, which would house more than fourteen families per acre. The case arose in the County court of Lake county and was heard by judge Perry Persons at Waukegan. No attack was made by the petitioner upon the zoning Ordinance itself nor upon well-established zoning principles but the attack was directed only against the particular fourteen families per acre provision as applied to apartments; and Judge Person held this regulation to be drastic, unreasonable and unconstitutional; also upon the ground that under the language of the ordinance itself the restriction was not applicable to apartments. The petitioner was represented by Alexander H. Marshall, of the Chicago law firm of Marshall & Marshall.

The case was appealed to the Illinois Supreme Court; and on account of the importance of and widened interest in the case, the Chicago Regional Planning association raised funds with which to employ special counsel to obtain the fullest possible presentation of the case in the Su-

preme Court in support of the zoning regulation.

The Illinois Supreme Court, in its opinion, affirms the decision of Judge Persons of the Lake County court.
