putting forth superlative effort in contributing to the success of New Trier Day.

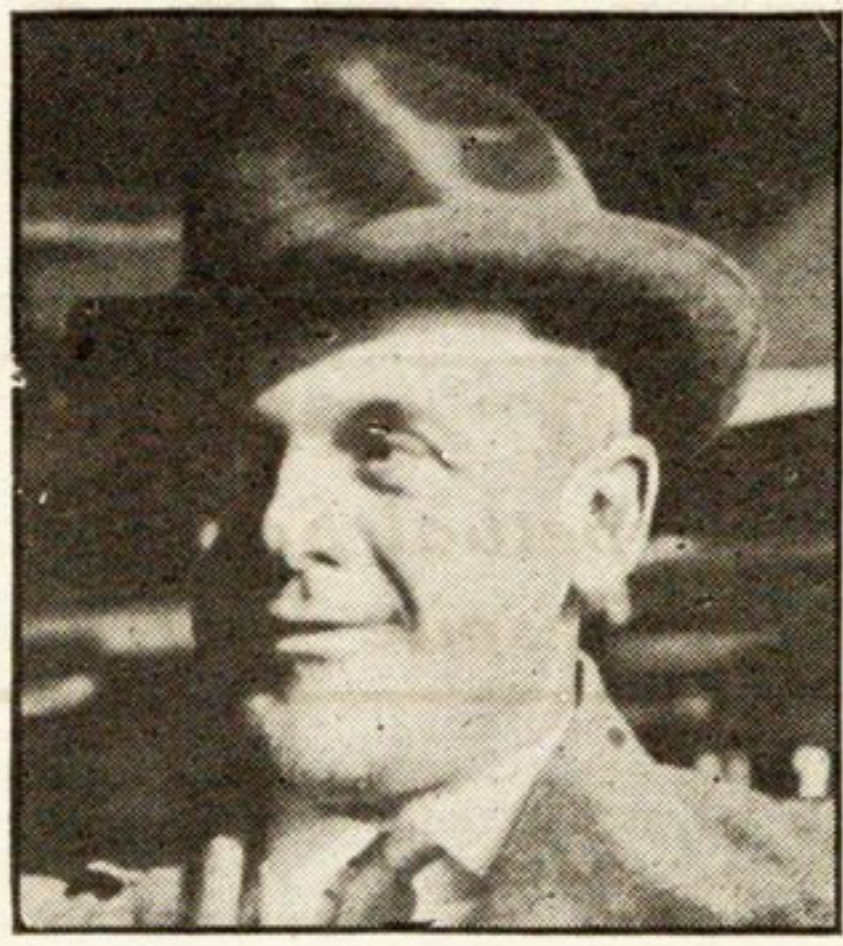
Mr. Nord is assigned to several important New Trier Day committees and he is finding time to give every item under his direction the same business-like attention he accords his thriving tailoring establishment.

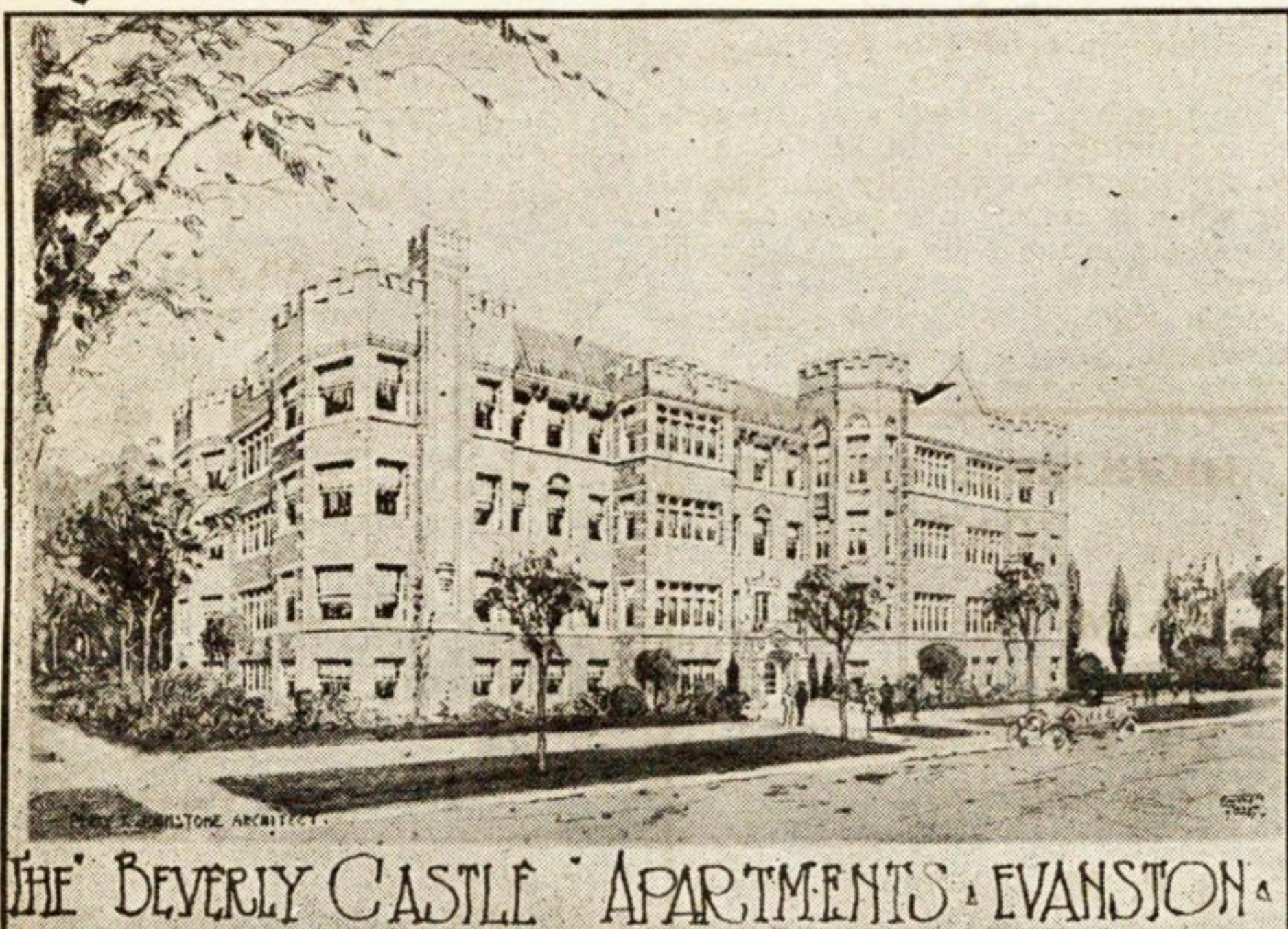
Mr. Gapen will usher the big Chicago Elevated band into the north shore next Thursday and he'll also secure good music for the afternoon and evening dancing.

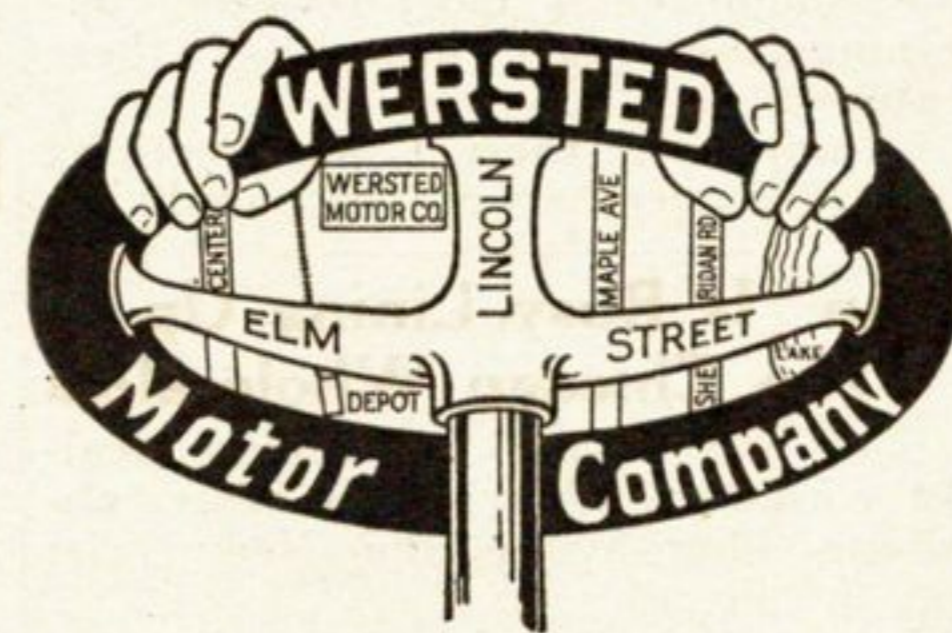
