We regret to have to announce that Joseph Monkhouse, of Altona, on Saturday last fell and broke his arm.

Mr. Wickson, butcher, St. Lawrence market, Toronto, had on exhibition on Saturday, two very fine spring lambs from Scott Bros. Aurora. Their live weight was 43 pounds and 27 pounds respectively.

Ontario is a great reading province. There are now 248 public libraries in the province and an increase of 91 over last year. The Government gives a grant to each library to aid in its maintenance.

President McKinley is in favor of the ratification of the Arbitration Treaty with Great Britain. A vote will be taken at an early date and a substantial majority in its favor is expected.

We cannot divest ourselves of personal responsibility to God in any such light and erring fashion. You and you alone can sin. God gave us a conscience capable of knowing the difference, and consequently of choosing between right and wrong. It is this fact that creates an unalterable distinction between us and the indelibly varied forms of beings that lie around us. The spiritual laws are on a far higher level than the natural laws, because they are founded in the nature of the Divine Being Himself, for he is the moral and spiritual law personified. Consequently, sin against the law is a direct act of hostility against God. If we were allowed to develop it would stop at nothing short of driving God from the throne of the universe. As treason is the most serious offence against human laws, because it is a blow against the foundations of society so sin has the blackest hue, because it is a blow aimed at the sovereignty of God Himself."

Entitled to carry on in the railway car an almost unlimited quantity of goods to be disposed of in the city. The railway companies think this has had the effect of causing great inconvenience to passengers who were travelling on ordinary tickets, as many seats were often occupied by farm products. Henceforth such goods must be carried as freight, and the proper charges paid upon them.

TORONTO TELEGRAM.—Two interesting young men are in attendance at the Court of General Sessions this week. One of them lives in Whit-church, is nearly 30 years of age, and has not before this, been 10 miles away from home. It was necessary to send a constable out to convey him safely to the city. As the train approached Scarborough Junction one saw the word "Castoria" painted in huge letters on a barn. He remarked: "I say Bill look there. There is the place where they make castor oil." It is amusing to see their wonder and astonishment as they take in the city sights; especially do the trolley cars perplex them. So absorbed are they as they go along the streets that one of them actually falls over himself, not being accustomed to smooth going. Several times officer Stewart caught him as he was going down, and brought him to time.

THE SOUDAN.—News from the Sudan shows that great excitement prevails there. The Derivishes are making great preparations in view of the projected advance of the Anglo Egyptian expedition on Berber. The Khalifa is rallying on Osman Digna to repel the advance of the Anglo Egyptian, forces up the Nile and has appointed him Governor of Berber, with the title of Emir of Emirs. Osman Digna has taken up his quarters at Berber, and has called out upwards of 25,000 Derivishes many of whom are well armed with rifles recently purchased by the Khalifa from Abyssinians. Advice from the Egyptian spies, however, indicate that the mass of Derivishes are reluctant to fight, and that Osman Digna has been compelled to dispatch a force of 3,000 men to traverse the country calling upon the Arabs to join his standard under penalty of death. The first news in ten months has also been received from the European prisoners at Omdurman, the military camp of the Khalifa, near Khartoum. They are in a state of tremendous anxiety, and fear they will be massacred directly the Khalifa finds he is unable to resist the advance of the Anglo Egyptian army.
