The House of Worth.

Worth, the most famous of Parisian dressmakers, whose name for half: a century has suggested everything that is tasteful and sparkling in the art of dress, was not a Frenchman at all, but an Englishman. His full name was Charles F. Worth, and he was born at Bourne, Lincolnshire, in 1825. He was the son of a lawyer's clerk, and his first start in life was as a salesman in a Loudon drapery scop. Dissatisfied with his position, he crossed to France and entered the service of Mme. Gagelin, at that time one of the foremost madistes in Paris; he worked for her as designer. It is said he came to Paris with only one sovereign in his pocket.

He left Mme. Gagelin to start for himself and took a flat in the Rue de la Paix, where his firm is still situated. At that time-during the Second Empire-it was a fashionable residential street, and the inhabitants objected to the presence of a business man among them. The Empress Eugenie-took an interest in the young man and helped to make his fortune. Besides his designs, his particular contribution to the business of dressmaking was to introduce the modern cratem, of the dressmaker's supplying the materials as well as cutting and making them


