Just the Thing

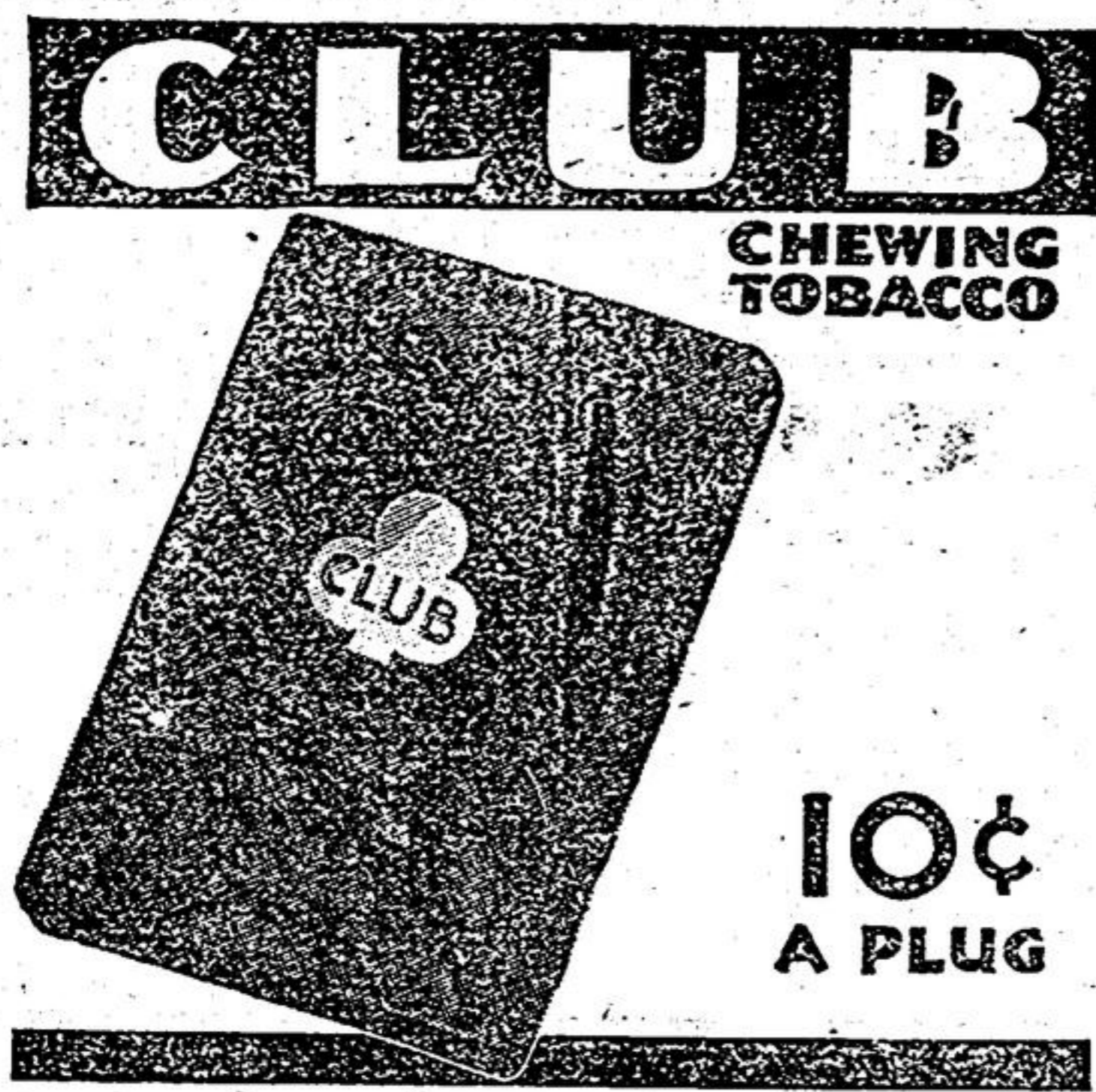

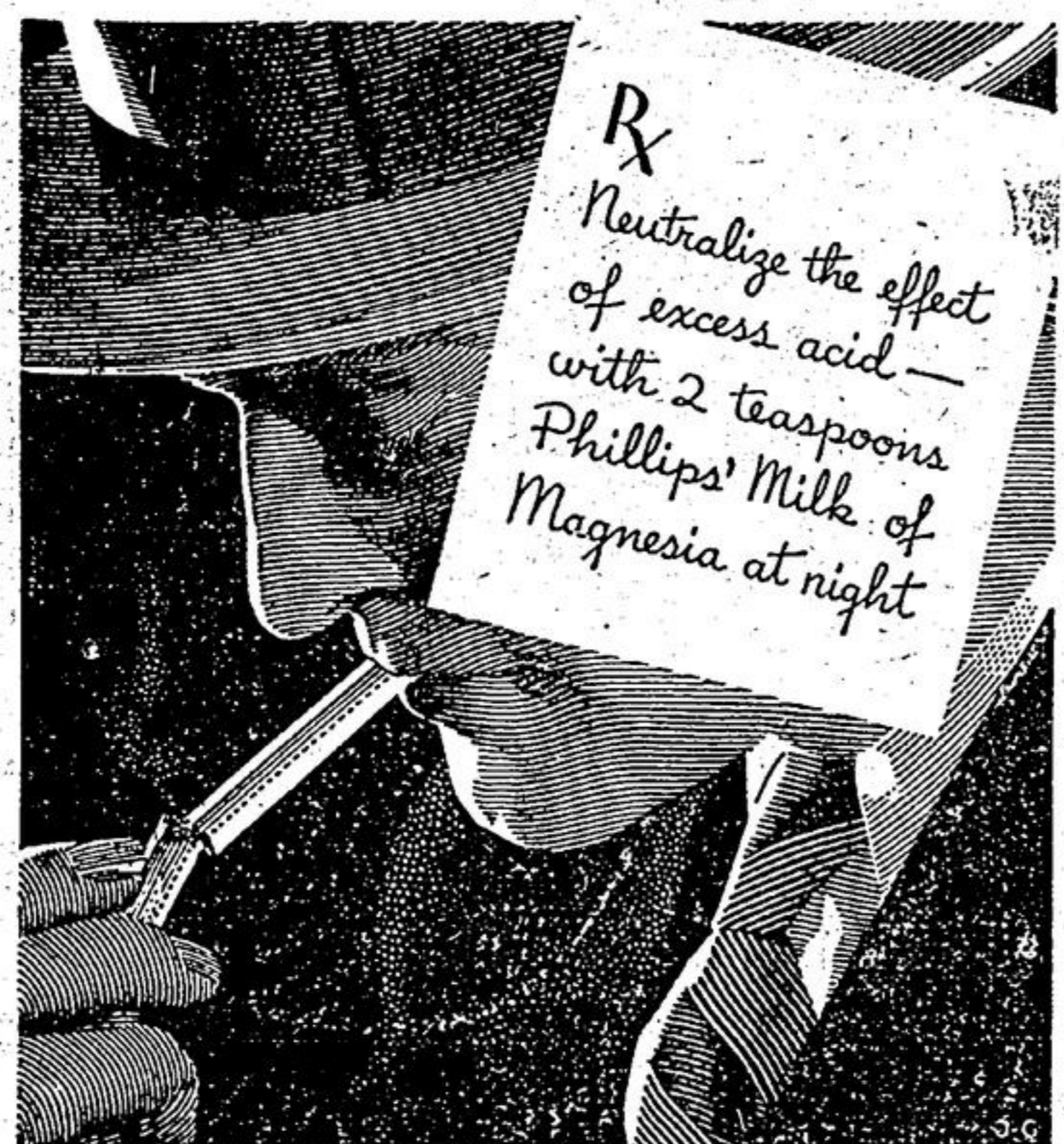

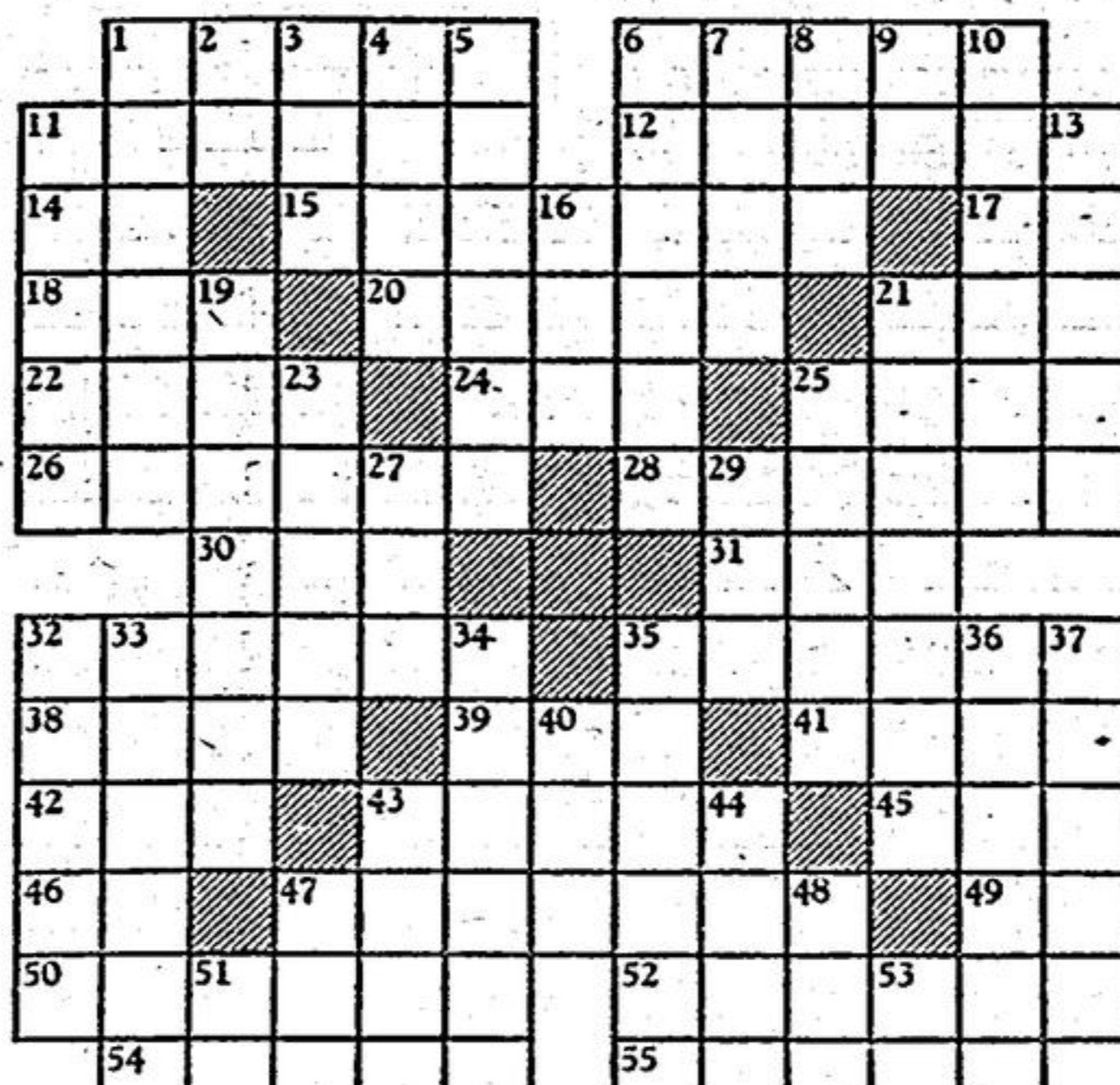
