

#### Canada's Reindeer Herd Nears End of Long Trak


Ottawa.-The long trek of Canada's reindeer herd from western Alaska to the Mackenzie River delta is now nearly ended. T. G. Murphy, Minister of the Interior, stated that the herd, which has been travelling since December, 1929, has arrived at the wes bank of the Mamkenzie River at the delta where it flows into the Arctic

The delta is about seventy-five miles wide, and twenty miles of this route does not furnish sufficient fodder to sustain the herd. It would be necessary to drive across this twenty miles at greater speed.

Since the fawning season has now arrived this is impossible, according to word received here. As there is good pasturage on the west side the Lomen Corporation, which is responsible for the delivery of the herd, has decided to pasture the animals where they now are until next autumn.
