Oldest Store Changes Hands

In Woodstock—Woodroffe Firm Is Going Out of Business

Woodstock.—Established in 1843 by David Barr, and acquired by Robert Woodroffe in 1864, the Woodroffe jewelry store, oldest retail establishment in Woodstock, is going out of business, and has been sold to M. R. Friend of Toronto.

Advancing age of the senior partner and the desire of Rev. Dr. Woodroffe to return to the ministry, has made the step necessary. For 70 years this jewelry business has been conducted at the corner of Dundas and Graham streets. Robert Woodroffe, who established the business there, was the father of the present senior partner. His partner and son, Dr. R. W. Woodroffe, came here to manage the business a short time ago, after the death of Arthur Woodroffe, his brother. Dr. Woodroffe was a leading Episcopalian minister in Detroit.

PROGRESS IN AIR IS SEEN

British Fliers — Planes And Glider Give Fine Exhibition

London, Eng.—Seventeen hundred guests of the Royal Aeronautical Society recently watched a display of flying at the Fairey Aerodrome, in Heath Row, which demonstrated high efficiency of the modern British civilian and military airplane.

The occasion was the society's garden party, which in this jubilee year has taken pride of place as the first great aerial event of the season. More than 50 airplanes took part in the flying demonstration.

Outstanding in the aerobatic evolutions were the "turns" given by four military aircraft—three single-seat fighters and one light bomber—though to the expert eye the flying of the small civil craft was equally interesting. But, as always, the high-powered warplanes provided the supreme moments of the display, their 700 horsepower engines enabling the pilots to execute breath-taking upward rolls, rocket climbs and dives at more than 300 miles an hour.

An unusual incident was the arrival of G. E. Collins in a glider from Reading, about 20 miles away. Collins, who holds the British gliding distance record of 98 1/2 miles, had arranged to be towed to a height of 4,000 feet over Reading. At a height of 2,000 feet the towing cable parted, but he determined to continue the journey. Helping wind was negligible. On the way to Heath Row, he gained another 2,000 feet in height, and descended over the aerodrome in a series of tight turns. In spite of the mishap at the start he arrived only five minutes behind the time listed on the program.

MUSSOLINI'S MONSTER.
Primo Carnera, former world's heavyweight champion, was born in Venice, Italy, Oct. 25, 1903.

This man-mountain now stands 6 feet 7 inches and weighs a mere 270 pounds.

Odd Malady

St. Thomas.—Reports of numbers of cattle and horses in the district suffering from bloating, with some fatalities, after being turned on pasture and also of cattle suffering from depraved appetites and chewing on bones, wood and dirt, brought Professor Knox of the Ontario Agricultural College, and Dr. McIntosh of the Ontario Veterinary College here recently to make an investigation in company with F. S. Thomas, agricultural representative.

The bloating, Professor Knox stated, is probably due to a change of diet, cattle that were on dry feed being turned on lush pasture. The condition that has caused cattle to chew bones and wood may also have some bearing on the bloating, he said. Dr. McIntosh said that the chewing of bones and wood occurs as a result of deficiencies in the diet, and in this particular instance, phosphorus is lacking. The animals most frequently affected are young, milking cows.

The condition usually manifests itself in the spring when cattle are first turned out to grass at the conclusion of a long stable feeding period.

Hays and grains grown in years of drought such as occurred last year are quite deficient in phosphorus, he said. Dr. Macintosh advised farmers who

have reported cattle with depraved appetites, to correct the condition by the addition of bran, oil cake or soya bean meal to the grain rations. The addition of two pounds of bone meal and one pound of iodized salt to every 100 pounds of grain was also advised.
