

# One Game to Decide Whitchurch Championship

Big Crowd Expected for Township Title Game Thursday Night.

Riding high on a one-goal lead obtained over King City in the first game of their round last Thursday, Ballantrae were forced right back into a deadlocked position again last week, when King took a 4-3 decision in overtime in the local arena. As in the first game both teams played a rugged brand of hockey with a back-checking consistency that made play very ragged.

Each team counted once in the first stanza, but King tallied the lone counter of the mid-session to pull along side the men of Shell, 4-4 on the round. There were few penalties, Nesbitt for Ballantrae getting the only charge, and that for boarding. Both squads scored again in the last period, and sent the game into overtime, when King for the first time in the series took the lead. Before the ten-minute session was up however, McNelly drilled one from well out, which trickled through Forfar's legs, to again place the round on even terms.

This comeback by King City necessitated a third game Tuesday night, report of which is found elsewhere in this issue.

Vandorf 5, Lemonville 4. Lou Morden, Lemonville's tower of defensive strength was noticeably absent, when the 7th liners were nosed out 5-4, by the Vandorf Blues.

Going into this final game tied 3-3, Hennie of Vandorf, and Tindall of Lemonville each scored in the first period to keep the teams still on even terms.

The mid-session was scoreless, with play see-sawing up and down, neither team showing any marked advantage, although both were subject to very close-calls around the net.

Both teams ganged considerably in the final round, but most of the scoring chances went hay-wire, through lack of organization in the opposition zone.

With sticks flying high, tempers exploded in several quarters and two penalties were necessary before the fistic action subsided. Both players returned the ice with no damage done, but when Lemonville drew a second trip to the cooler for boarding, Vandorf took the lead, scoring with only four minutes remaining.

## UXBRIDGE TEAMS SPLIT ON HOCKEY DIFFERENCES

Only Two Teams Left to Battle For League Honors.

The hockey differences which have been smouldering in the Uxbridge League during the last week, broke out in a meeting of all the representatives of the four teams concerned, at Uxbridge on Thursday afternoon, when Goodwood pulled from the running, leaving Stouffville and Sunderland to battle it out for the title.

Goodwood contend that, abiding by the rules laid down at the beginning of the season, the second and fourth place teams were to play off, as were the third and first place teams. However as Uxbridge came right to the eve of the finals and then defaulted, Goodwood, being the second place team, whom they should have met, claimed the bye, or that they should be considered winners of this semi-final round, owing to the Uxbridge default.

Stouffville and Sunderland on the other hand, held to the claim that, since there were but three teams left in the play-offs, the bye if any, should go to Sunderland, who finished at the top of the league. This would have meant a semi-final two out of three games between Stouffville and Goodwood, with the winner meeting Sunderland. Goodwood they claim were not entitled to the preference.

Goodwood did not feel inclined to accept this arrangement, as they claimed there was then the possibility of them having to play in two rounds, when they felt entitled to the ruling set down at the opening of the season. Thus they declined to continue in the league.

Stouffville felt equally justified in their stand and are thus left with Sunderland to decide a winner.

## NEW RESIDENTS BUY BRICK COTTAGE

## YORK COUNTY ONCE HAD A GIANT

Tom Gardiner Fled to New Brunswick, was Constantly Sought by Sheriff for Killing. Born Near Toronto.

Tom Gardiner must have been the strongest man who ever lived in York County according to a story in a file of aged newspapers at the public library down in St. John, N.B. His strength brought him tragedy.

He was born in York County in 1798. At Saint John he lifted a 1,200-pound anchor. Once when annoyed he raised two 200-pound men from their feet and banged their heads together. On another occasion he playfully tore up roots and all, an apple tree with a trunk four inches thick. Holding it only by a rung with one hand, he could lift above his head a chair-bearing a 175-pound man.

Gardiner knew nothing about wrestling but he defeated a famous wrestler from Nova Scotia. When word of this reached the Miramichi district of New Brunswick the greatest wrestler in that region set out for Tom's home to issue a challenge.
