

#### Predicts Hitler's Defeat

To grab the spotlight again as a great national hero, Adolf Hitler, who suffers both from; delusions of grandeur and split personality, will try to put himself at the head of a suicide; army of 1,000,000 men next summer in a frenzied attack upon the Allies. This theory was advanced in New York recently by Dr. David Seabury. Dr. Seabury believes that "the very frenzy of such a drive will result in its defeat and bring about Hitler's death." This is not the first prediction the wellknown psychologist has ven-: turned on the moves of Hitler will make. In October, 1938, he forecast the alliance i between Hitler and Stalin, because of the German chancellor's split personality.

A unit of the Canadian expeditionary force was being trained in the construction of trenches under a gas attack. The officer in command, not noticing the arrival of the war secretary, fired off a tear gas bomb. Stanley was not carrying a gas mask. The war secretary and his escort were caught in the gas.
