If you wish to feast your eyes on a grand sample of Ontario potatoes just visit the farm of Mr. J. H. Walwork, north of Ballantrae. where thousands of bags of murphies of the Chippawa variety are being dug right now. Mr. Wallwork who has a prize herd of cattle also "knows his potatoes." He is one of the big producers having planted between 35 and 40 acres, and the average yield will be 250 bags to the acre, a marvelous return.


