## Chippawa Potatoes 250 Bags to Acre

If you wish to feast your eyes on a grand sample of Ontario potatoes just visit the farm of Mr. J. H. Wallwork, north of Ballantrae, where thousands of bags of murphies of the Chippawa variety are being dug right now. Mr. Wallwork who has a prize herd of cattle also "knows his potatoes." He is one of the big producers having planted between 35 and 40 acres, and the average yield will be 250 bags to the acre, a marvellous return.

Of course this farmer used plenty of bug killer and sprayed for blight, expensive operations, but he is satisfied with the accomplishment, a job well done. The Chippawa are a lovely white potato, shallow eyes, and in the case of the Wallwork production they are twice the size of other common varieties, but you never find a hollow one, Mr. Wallwork says.

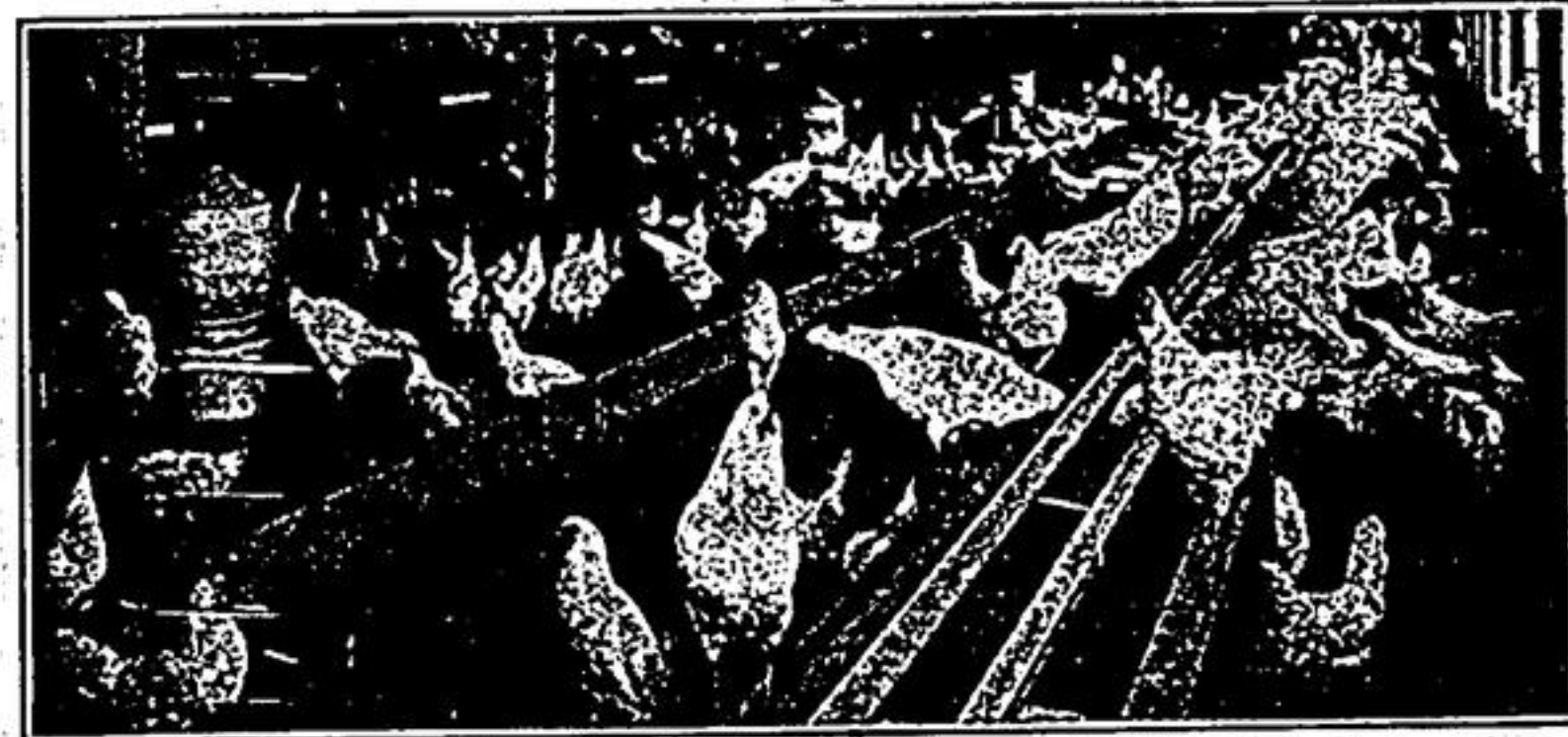
