

Why We Must Vote!

Our right to vote is one of our most precious possessions. The people of Socialist countries lost their right to vote and therefore lost their right to a free press, freedom of speech and freedom of worship. They lost their right to work where they might like to work; they lost their right to change jobs; Labour lost its right to bargain collectively; (Who is silly enough to think he can bargain with a Socialist boss). Actually, those people lost all their right and freedom of action... and they thus lost their right to a change in Government, without a war.

THE C.C.F. AND HITLER

Occasionally some misled person is heard to say that the heads of the C.C.F. do not think along the lines of the late Socialist Germany. In the first place, who are the heads of the C.C.F.? Could it be that Coldwell is an innocent figurehead? Certainly, one of the heads is a man who came from Russia twenty odd years ago and, with his name changed to David Lewis, is now proceeding to tell us how to run our country. He is co-author of a book "Make this your Canada." Consider the writer and consider the book. Could anything be more ridiculous? "Mein Kampf" or "Mine Canada" would have been a more appropriate title. Imagine these political upstarts and their inexperienced "planners" running our stores, our farms, our mines, our factories, our transportation systems, our churches and, in fact, our way of living!

You don't think they would? That is what they want you to think, but here is the evidence. Turn to page 545 of the House of Commons Debates, 1940, and read what Mr. Coldwell, present National Leader of the C.C.F. said:—

"Many of us are realizing for the first time today that the secret of the recent success of the Germans is the fact that they consciously planned their economic structure."

Wonderful, isn't it! In "Co-operation of Catastrophe"—William Irvine (C.C.F.) "We do not believe in the so-called rights of private property, nor shall we recognize precedent or practice in connection therewith."

This applies to farmers, home owners, newspaper or publishing firms and all property owners.

THE GERMAN SYSTEM AGAIN ADMIRER BY MR. COLDWELL!

Speaking of the German system and of Communism, in the House of Commons in March, 1942, M. J. Coldwell said:—

"The basis (of both) was the control of the economic resources and Labour of those nations... they did a remarkable job..."

Note the Control of Labour statement. Farmers Please Note:

"Ultimately farmers could stay on their farms as long as they wished but they could not will the property on their death to anyone else... Capitalists were a common group of exploiters. He would take their leaders and dump them in the lake..." B. E. Leavens, C.C.F., M.P.P. for Woodbine, Ont. from his speech at Orillia, Ont., October 22nd, 1943, as reported in the Orillia Packet & Times.

(Meantime, the C.C.F. in Saskatchewan have already passed legislation which permits taking away the farms, the stores, the businesses and industries of present owners.)

Just in case there should be any doubt about the matter, the Calgary Herald, Nov. 10, 1943, reports Mr. Winch's speech:

"...It's TIME WE HAD A REVOLUTION! During the question period he (Mr. Winch) told a member of the audience that a change is coming, PEACEFULLY OR NOT"... Asked about the posi-

tion of the POLICE AND MILITARY FORCES in the event of moves for a change, Mr. Winch replied that when "WE BECOME THE GOVERNMENT WE WILL INSTITUTE SOCIALISM IMMEDIATELY AND WOULD USE THE POWER OF THE POLICE AND THE MILITARY FORCES TO FORCE THOSE OPPOSED TO OBEY THE LAW, those who defied the government's will WOULD BE TREATED AS CRIMINALS," he declared, adding: "If CAPITALISM SAYS 'NO,' THEN WE KNOW THE ANSWER... SO DID RUSSIA." He told another questioner that "WE'RE GOING TO SCRAP THE B.N.A. ACT..."

What about our Savings... the money we have deposited with our banks. Read this:

"There seems to be no reason, for example, why interest should be paid upon deposits at present... nor can we see much likelihood of circumstances arising under a Socially planned economy in which it would be desirable to pay interest upon deposits..." Social Planning for Canada, page 307.

When the C.C.F. takes over an industry or Company, what about the few securities which we may have saved for and purchased throughout our lifetime? From "From What is the Answer of the C.C.F." issued by B.C. C.C.F. Federal Campaign Committee, we get the answer:

"There would be some form of compensation. This could be awarded by means of non-interest bearing bonds..." Scraps of paper for good securities!

What about our Victory Bonds and War Savings Certificates? Mr. Coldwell in the House of Commons, Jan. 1942, gave the answer:

"The present loan policy should be replaced by one of compulsory interest free loans."

What about people who, from their Savings, have purchased a small building in a business section, or a farm, or a rooming house, or a garage site, or a parking lot, or have invested hard earned money in anything with a view to building up a form of security and income. Here is the answer from their "Social Planning for Canada," page 283:

"Interest on capital and rent on land should be maintained in socialized production as a necessary accounting device, but they will no longer accrue to private individuals as income."

Who will work for the recent arrival from Russia; the man with the changed name, and his socialist partners? In "Democracy Needs Socialism" they give the answer:


"They would have to be men who were loyal to the Socialist ideals of the Government, otherwise they might use their positions of power to sabotage the plan."

These are the answers by the spokesmen of the C.C.F.

W.P.T.B. QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS

- Q.—My husband is being discharged from the army. Where do I apply for his civilian ration book?
- A.—You don't... on discharge, servicemen receive an application form for their civilian ration book... this form is given to them at the demobilization centre. The form may be taken or mailed to the nearest Local Ration Board Office and a ration book will be issued immediately. Your husband should apply for his book immediately after his discharge as the book will contain coupons only from the date of application... not from the date of discharge. Ration Board officials naturally assume that coupons are not required if they are not applied for.
- Q.—Is there any ceiling price set on houses? I want to sell a house and have been told I must apply to have a price set?
- A.—No... there is no ceiling price on real estate. The value of real property varies widely depending on the locality, the condition in which it has been kept, etc. and for this reason it would be difficult to set a maximum price on every house in Canada.
- Q.—Are grocery stores which stay open at night allowed to charge higher prices than those open only until 6 p.m.? Why are

these stores allowed to stay open so late?

A.—Whether a store closes at 6 p.m. or later has nothing to do whatever with the prices they charge... price ceilings apply to all grocery stores... the fact they remain open late does not entitle them to charge more than the lawful maximum prices. There is no WPTB regulation regarding the business hours of grocery stores... each locality has its own municipal regulations.

Q.—Is there a ceiling price on shrubs and plants?

A.—No... the prices of plants and

shrubs are exempt from Board regulations... it is very difficult... if not impossible... to fix maximum prices on products which depend on so many variable conditions such as weather, yield of products resulting from the labour involved, etc.

Q.—I have a 1939 Ford Sedan which I want to sell. Can you tell me what price I should ask for the car?

A.—It would be impossible to tell you the maximum price you can ask without knowing full particulars about your car... get in touch with the nearest Wartime Prices and Trade

Board office... they will advise you the ceiling price for the make, year and model of your car.


