ROOM FOR IMPROVEMENTS IN CARS

Asked what basic changes they would like to see in their automobiles in the next five years, a group of Canadian businessmen and engineers polled by The Financial Post came through with a bumper crop of suggestions. Included were hopes for power shock absorbers, built-in hydraulic jack, polarized anti-glare windshields, engine air pump for inflating tires, water and ice-proof brakes, air conditioning. Implicit in all replies was the aim of greater safety, higher engine efficiency, more comfortable riding.

STRIKES CAUSE SOAP SHORTAGE

The current Canadian soap shortage is the direct result of industrial disputes at Canada's two major soda chemical plants and not due to poor supplies of oils and fats, which are considered satisfactory. F. H. Lehberg, Oils and Fats Administrator of the Prices Board said.

Mr. Lehberg pointed out that if it were not for the acute shortage of caustic soda, so important to the soap industry, Canadian soap manufacturers would have equalled if not exceeded the 1945 production of 255,000,000 pounds. Many manufacturers are now making soap on a 35 per cent production basis of last year and if they do not receive sufficient supplies of caustic soda in the near future, production will be practically at a standstill, Mr. Lehberg said.
