**HOW 100 BUS. TURNIPS GROW TO ACRE**

Between 75 and 100 growers gathered for the annual turnip meeting held in connection with the Convention of the Ontario Crop Improvement Association in Toronto in February heard John Dales, Cargill, and Nicholas Durrer, Mildmay, explain how they produced more than a thousand bushels of table turnips per acre in 1946.

Mr. Dales reported a yield of 1,082 bushels of shipping turnips per acre. Mr. Durrer's yield of shipping turnips was 1,023 bushels per acre. He attributed some of the success to the use of salt and fertilizer. Applications of 200 pounds of commercial fertilizer and 200 pounds of salt per acre were made to the 2 acres entered in the Crop Competition. Another 2 acres, not fertilized or salted, produced 800 bushels to the acre. Mr. Durrer reported that the turnips fertilized and salted kept on growing and did not slow up during the dry weather, as did the turnips where no salt was applied. Speaking from 35 years experience as a shipper, R.C. Thompson, Lynden, said that many shoppers went to the stores not knowing what vegetables they would buy until they saw what was offered. For that reason he considered highly important that turnips should be attractive and of suitable size. The Buffalo market, he said, takes a turnip 5 to 6 inches in diameter; Cleveland, 4 1/2 to 5 1/2 inches; Birmingham, 3 1/2 to 4 1/2 inches; and Philadelphia, 2 to 4 inches. "We are constantly turning down offers because we know we can't give them those small turnips," this shipper admitted. Speaking for the Consumer Section, Dominion Department of Agriculture, Miss Marian Cassel-

man extolled the turnip and said it was rich in those health promoting substances called vitamins. "Several are found in this vegetable," she said.
