Verse 34.—"I will defend this city ..... for mine own sake." In order that His own name might not be dishohored, God would undertake to destroy the enemy and save His people. He could not forget His promise to David (Psa. 89: 20-37). Verse 35.—"That night ...... the

angel of the Lord ..... smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand." It is evident that God sent a plague upon them so that the Assyrian army was literally annihilated. When the people of Judah arose in the morning their foes were all dead men. Verse 36.—"Sennacherib ....... de-
