## NEW PRICES FOR EXPORT EGGS

With the Canadian contract for the supply of eggs to Britain unhampered by the new measures being taken in the old land to strengthen Britain's economic position, the poultry division of the Dominion Dept. of Agriculture draws particular attention to the new increased prices for export eggs that will go into effect, Sept. 1. These prices will be for fall and winter buying and will remain in effect until late next January.

Per dozen, the new prices at the various shipping points are as follows: Charlottetown 49c; Halifax 49 1/2c; Montreal 49 1/2c; Toronto 49c; St. John's 49c.
