

A ROTTEN EGG DEAL BRINGS HEAVY FINE
 "This is a racket, pure and simple," said Crown Attorney Alex C. Hall in police court at Whitby,

demanding the maximum penalty for Sydney Adler, charged with buying rejected eggs at Lindsay without a license, under the provincial Farmers' Products Grades

and Sales Act. Adler was fined \$50 and costs or one month and refused time to pay by Magistrate F. Ebbs, who said: "This has to be stopped. When bad eggs are bought this way no one has any idea how they are going to be disposed of. Some of them may be used in compounds to make custards and children may eat them."
 "You are not charged with selling the eggs. You are charged with purchasing them in an unlawful manner, or the penalty would be much more severe. As it is I am fining you the maximum for this particular offence."
 Termed by the crown "a nefarious traffic in eggs," the case created wide attention, and government poultry experts were in court to testify.

167 Bloods
 John Steele of Hamilton, poultry products inspector said he examined two cases of rejects on a truck driven by Adler, and they contained 167 bloods and other harmful types of eggs.
 "What are the illegitimate uses of such eggs?" asked the crown.
 "They are used for human consumption," said witness.
 "I was stated that the rotten eggs were normally used in tanneries to aid the leather, or to feed foxes."

X-RAY ONLY PERFECT MEANS OF DISCOVERING TUBERCULOSIS

Out of a million Canadian recruits x-rayed during the first four years of the war, 3,300 were found to have active cases of tuberculosis, Dr. Tomlinson, medical officer of health for Pickering Township said last week.

Dr. Tomlinson made this statement in connection with the free x-ray of all Pickering Township beginning here October 24 sponsored by the Board of Health in co-operation with the Ontario Tuberculosis Association and the Ontario Department of Health.

"Some people ask why we go to the trouble and expense of finding cases of tuberculosis when the people concerned are not ill," continued Dr. Tomlinson. "The answer is simply that long before the disease makes anyone visibly ill, disease germs can be given to other people. Every case of tuberculosis comes from someone else."

To those wishing to know what they can do to assist in the free Pickering Township survey, Dr. Tomlinson said:

"Give the project your hearty support by advancing arguments in favour of the project whenever it is discussed. And when you can, do a little missionary work by stressing the importance of the survey in building a healthy community."

TWO MOTOR PLATES FOR 1948

Discontinued during the war in the interests of economy, dual license plates will again appear on Ontario vehicles in 1948, the Ontario Department of Highways announces.

Next year's plates will have figures and letters on a dark blue background. The design of the plates has not been altered except for a change in the Crown at the top of each plate.

A very great shortage of steel during the war forced provinces and states to issue rear vehicle markers only. Reports now indicate that most of the provinces and states are reverting to the two-plate system which is recognized as essential in the interests of law enforcement.
