"No, it is not margarine," said a spokesman for the Canadian Government, pointing out that illipe butter is used mainly as a substitute for cocoa butter in the manufacture of chocolate and chocolate coatings for the biscuit trade, with this illipe butter providing a fat that has a somewhat higher melting point than cocoa butter and which tends to prevent the bloom on the chocolate or coating.



Answer: Sugar should be carefully measured. Too much will retard freezing. Too little will make the dessert icy, with a flaky texture. When canned fruit is substituted for fresh fruit reduce the amount of sugar called for in the recipe.
