#### Supplies Reach Foodless Lake Simcoe Islanders

Snake Island, Ont, April 11-The population of seven persons on this Lake Simcoe island ended a brief famine last night when they ate their first food since Wednesday. The three-day fast was brought on when ice between the island and Keswick broke up

suddenly last week. Caretaker Harold McGee had crossed for food a week ago, but brought back only enough food for a few days.

A small channel opened in the ice Saturday and McGee rowed across, only to be caught on the mainland when the channel closed. Yesterday he borrowed a steelbottomed boat and smashed his way to the island with food for his wife and two sons and for 87-yearold Jim Ashquabe and his two

The island is held by the Chippewa Indians and MeGee is the Indian Affairs Department's caretaker there.

#### Pale, Chastened Oleo Will Appear in May

Ontario's new Margarine Control money to pay what's owed to the Act won't go into effect before the second week in May. 
