Warned Against Two U.S. Firms

R. B. Whitehead, K.C. of Toronto, Provincial Supt. of Insurance warns that there are two companies transacting insurance business in Ontario which are not licensed under the Insurance Act to do so They are the American Farmers Insurance Company and the Bankers National Insurance Company both of Phoenix, Arizona.

He adds that representatives of these companies are known as "membership counsellers" and material furnished by the companies to such representatives includes applications for life and accident and sickness insurance.

Any person using or attempting to use such forms in the sale of insurance would be acting as an insurance agent within the meaning of the Insurance Act and would be contravening the provisions of the Act, so as to render themselves liable to prosecution.
