CUT IN FARM MACHINE BUYING IS PREDICTED

Canada's tractor-conscious farmer is so mechanized that he likely will cut down on machinery spending next year.

This was told to the Dominion Provincial Agriculture Conference in a paper prepared by one of the Federal Agriculture Department's machinery experts, Frank Shefrin. He estimated 1950 buying may

be reduced by 10 or 15 per cent of 1949 levels.

Reason for this slackening off, said Mr. Shefrin, lies in the fact that Canadian farmers purchased more machinery in the last three years than in the preceding nine.

BRIGADE LEADER WAS MILITIAMAN FOR 68 YEARS

Veteran of 68 years in the Canadian militia, Maj.-Gen. Robert Rennie, 87, died Saturday at Sunnybrook. Three weeks ago he suffered a fractured hip in a fall on the icy street. For many years he was president of the William Rennie Co., seed business, with which he was connected for more than 40 years.

Born in York County, General Rennie was the son of William and Sarah Glendenning Rennie. He enlisted as a rifleman with the Queen's Own Rifles of Toronto in 1881 and held the rank of honorary colonel of the regiment.

He was commissioned as a second lieutenant in 1887, and was made lieutenant-colonel in 1911. He was in command of the 2nd Battalion at the outbreak of the First World War, and at Valcartier was given command of the 3rd Battalion, Toronto Regiment.

His wife, the former Marion A. Ross, predeceased him. He leaves
