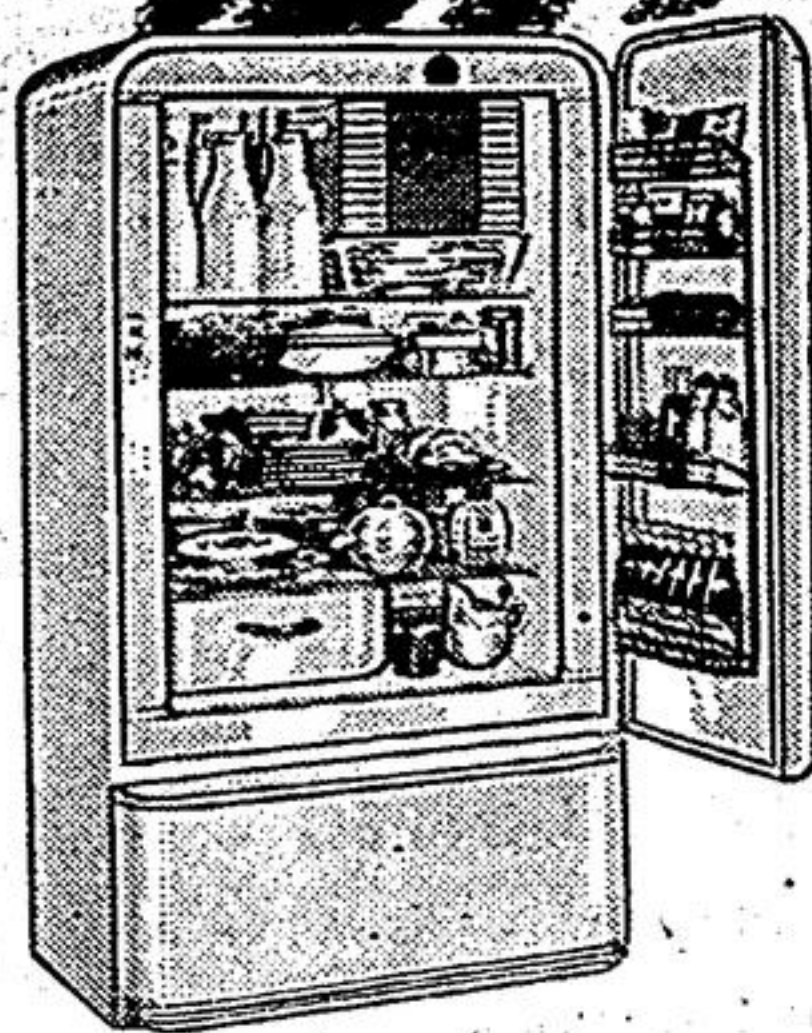

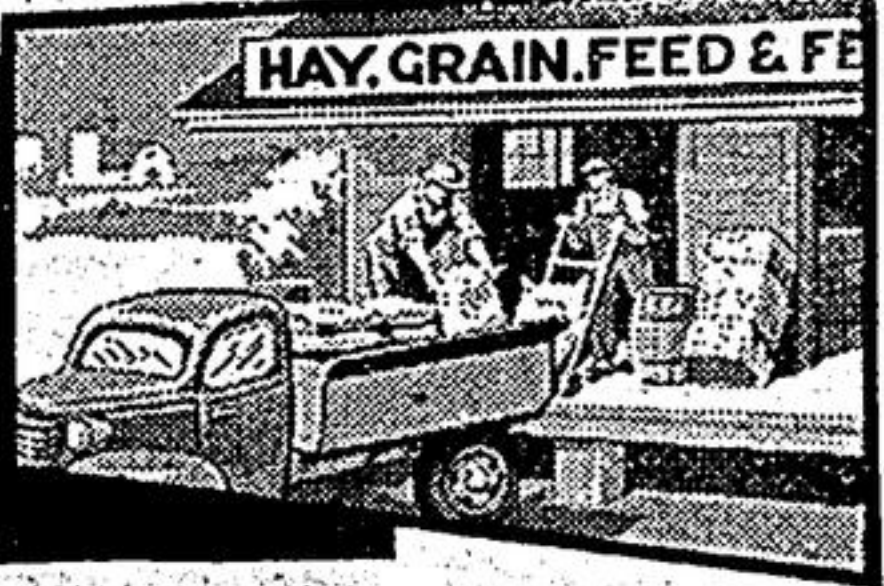

### A Letter from Your East York Member

Dear People of York, East:

Last week we had two stirring episodes in the House. The first occurred between Mr. Salzborg, (L.P. for St. Andrews), and Labour Minister Daley. It was over the fire in the factory you will recall where the windows were barred, everything was according to law even the bars on the windows, yet several lives were lost.

Mr. Daley, and the member for St. Andrews' riding exchanged most uncomplimentary remarks. At one stage Daley said "If I had a mind like yours I would keep my mouth shut," at another place in the debate Salzborg told the Minister, "You just sit like a toad on a log." It was not very elevating, but the subject was serious and we didn't get the Committee.

The second row which was a beauty was between C. H. Millard, (CCF West York), and the Minister of Education Porter, who was aided as things got hotter by an angry Prime Minister. The flare-up was over the Hope Commission studying education. It was appointed 5 years ago and has cost \$200,000, and has yet not brought in a full report.

This year the estimate for the Royal Commission popularly called the Hope Commission was \$50,000. At the end of a long critical speech, C. H. Millard moved that it be reduced to a \$1.00 which is a parliamentary method of showing dissatisfaction. Millard had urged that since Minister of Education Porter had announced a policy, the Commission's report was of no particular value to the Government. For some strange reason, Millard, who is a reasonable creature, scarcely ever spoke with angering the Prime Minister. Mr. Frost temporarily lost his poise and polish, and called the Official Opposition a great many things. The Commission that hasn't reported is a touchy subject.

In introducing the agricultural estimates, the Hon. Tom Kennedy made an interesting speech in which he told the House that he was just finishing 50 years of farming, and he told of the changes that had come over agriculture in 50 years. It was an amazing story and well worth hearing. In fact when he concluded it seemed to me everything had changed but the Legislature. Ontario is no longer a sparsely settled agriculture community. It now had a population of 4 1/2 million, and greatly varied in occupations, and still we are crowding all the business of Ontario into a few weeks of legislation as they did in the early days. The anger which flares up almost every day now in the House is more due to complete weariness than to anything else. Quebec, which is not as great an industrial province as Ontario, has a three months' session. Something is going to have to be done about the lengthening of the Session in Ontario.

The only reading of a bill on which there is real debate is the second, when the principle of the bill is discussed. When that is decided on the Speaker leaves the Chair and the House resolves into the Committee-of-the-Whole when the bill is discussed clause by clause. In Committee a member can speak as often as he wishes and the discussion is much more informal. Only bills which are very contentious are voted on when third reading is given. The votes almost always come on the principle of the bill. The fact that the Hon. Harold Scott is Minister of Mines and is also a very popular member of the House, did not save him from a very close scrutiny of his estimates. Agnes Macphail.

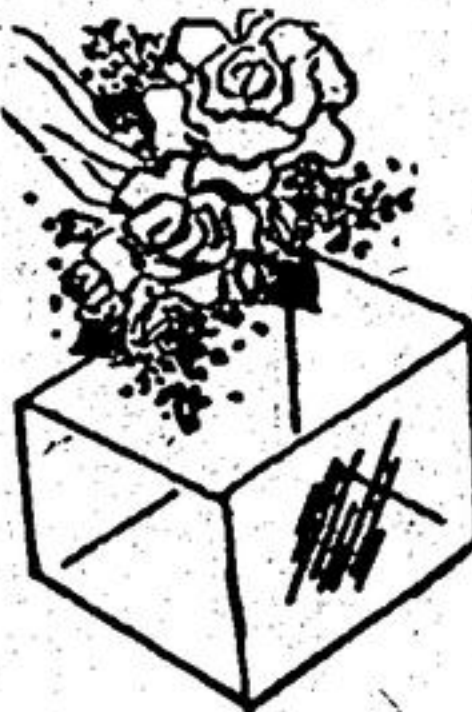
