## Plowing Match Plans Developing Rapidly

Plans for the 1950 International Plowing Match are going on rapidly, according to a report from the office of the Secretary-Manager J. A. Carroll. This year he expects not only a very large entry of Ontario plowmen, but also representation from other provinces, the United States and even from overseas. It is already established the Alberta Plowing Champion, Len Job, will be a competitor in the International, and it is expected champions from some of the other provinces will be on hand as well. There have been enquiries from overseas and, while there has been no definite commitment it is hoped a team of Britishers will compete.

This year's match, being held on Nottawasaga Valley Farms in Tecumseh Township of Simcoe County, will be officially opened by Hon. W. E. Harris, Minister of Citizenship and Immigration, Ottawa. The official opening of the International Plowing Match will be at 2.00 p.m. Wednesday, Oct. 11th. This is the first day of International competitions but Tuesday, Oct. 10th, will feature the local counties' match for Dufferin, Grey, Ontario, Simcoe and York

### To Honey Producers in Southern Ontario...

The Ontario Farm Products Marketing Board has received a request for the approval of a proposed marketing scheme under the provisions of the Farm Products Marketing Act, 1946, to regulate the marketing of honey sold in Southern Ontario.

A mail vote by ballot of producers of honey has been arranged so that the Board may determine whether a fairly representative number of producers are in favour of the scheme. The ballot with return envelope has been sent to all producers.

If you are producing honey in Ontario from ten or more colonies of bees, and are over 21 years of age, you are urgently requested to mark your ballot for or against the scheme and mail it at once in the return envelope provided.

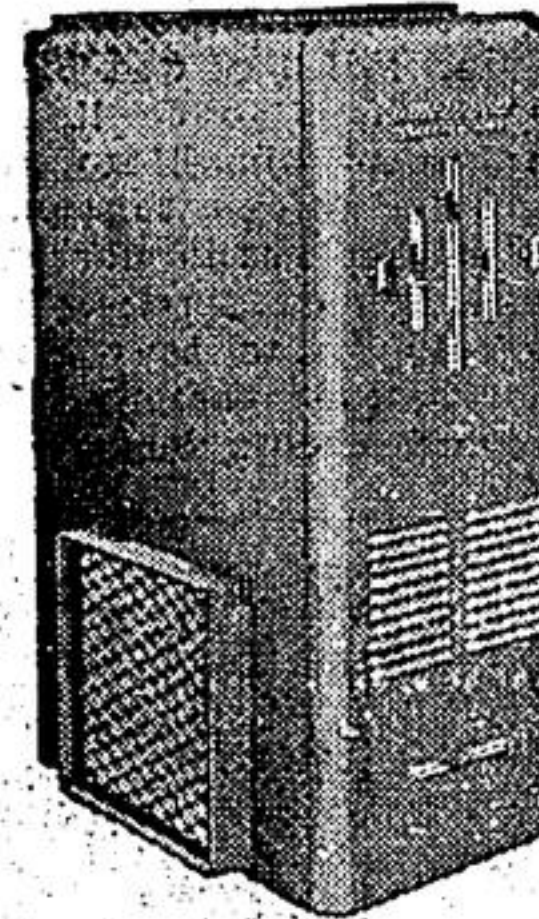

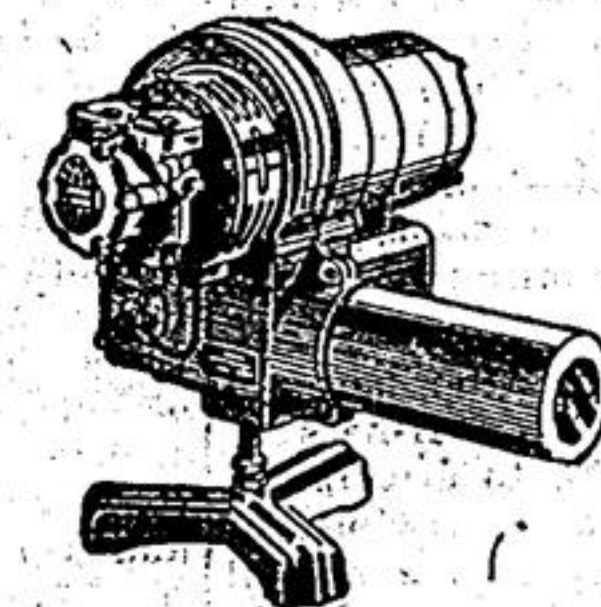
