The Ontario Farm Products Marketing Board has received a request for the approval of a proposed marketing scheme under the provisions of the Farm Products Marketing Act, 1946, to regulate the marketing of honey sold in Southern Ontario.

A mail vote by ballot of producers of honey has been arranged so that the Board may determine whether a fairly representative number of producers are in favour of the scheme. The ballot with return envelope has been sent to all producers.

If you are producing honey in Ontario from ten or more colonies of bees, and are over 21 years of age, you are urgently requested to mark your ballot for or against the scheme and mail it at oncein the return envelope provided.




